

Sub: Waiver of residency period for Pharmacists.
Ref: Railway Board's letter No. PC-V/98/T/11/18(A) dated
10.5.98 (PC-V/75, R.B.E. No. 100/98)

The Staff side had taken up the matter of relaxation in the residency period of two years in the grade Rs. 6500-10500, prescribed vide Railway Board's letter referred to above for promotion to the grade Rs. 7450-11500 in the cadre of Pharmacists. It was argued that imposition of such a condition is depriving the senior persons in the cadre of the immediate benefit of the grade Rs. 7450-11500, allotted to them by the V Central Pay Commission. It was also argued that some of the senior most persons would not get the benefit of this grade due to imposition of 2 years residency clause, and would retire in the grade Rs. 6500-10500 itself.

2. After careful examination of the matter, the Board have, in partial modification of the above quoted letter, decided that, the residency period of two years in the grade Rs. 6500-10500 prescribed as eligibility condition for promotion to the post of Chief Pharmacist I in the scale of Rs. 7450-11500 may be relaxed to one year subject to the condition that the total service in the grade Rs. 6500-10500 and Rs. 5500-9000 should not be less than 4 years. This will be a one-time relaxation to be applied only for filling up the additional posts becoming available in the higher grades as a result of V CPC's recommendations.

कर्मचारी पक्ष ने फार्मासिस्टों के कांडर में 7450-11500 ₹० के ग्रेड में पदोन्नति के लिए रेलवे बोर्ड के उपर्युक्त पत्र द्वारा निर्धारित किए गये अनुसार, 6500-10500 ₹० के ग्रेड में दो वर्ष की रेजीडेन्सी अवधि में छूट देने का मुद्दा उठाया था. यह तर्क दिया गया था कि इस प्रकार की शर्त लगाए जाने से कांडर में कार्यरत वरिष्ठ कर्मचारी पांचवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग द्वारा आर्बिट्रट 7450-11500 ₹० के ग्रेड के तत्काल लाभ से वंचित रह जाते हैं. यह तर्क भी दिया गया था कि दो वर्षों की रेजीडेन्सी शर्त के लगाए जाने के कारण कुछ वरिष्ठतम कर्मचारी इस ग्रेड का लाभ प्राप्त नहीं कर पायेंगे, तथा वे 6500-10500 ₹० के ग्रेड में ही सेवानिवृत्त हो जाएंगे.

2. इस मामले की ध्यानपूर्वक जांच करने के बाद, बोर्ड ने उपर्युक्त पत्र में आंशिक आशोधन करते हुए, यह विनिश्चय किया है कि 7450-11500 ₹० के वेतनमान में मुख्य फार्मासिस्ट 1 के पद पर पदोन्नति के लिए पात्रता शर्त के रूप में निर्धारित 6500-10500 ₹० के ग्रेड में दो वर्ष की रेजीडेन्सी अवधि में इस शर्त के साथ एक वर्ष की छूट दी जाए कि 6500-10500 ₹० तथा 5500-9000 ₹० के ग्रेड में कुल सेवा कम से कम चार वर्षों की होनी चाहिए. पांचवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों के परिणामस्वरूप, उच्च ग्रेडों में उपलब्ध होने वाले अतिरिक्त पदों को भरने के लिए ही इसका इस्तेमाल केवल एक बारगी छूट के रूप में किया जाएगा.


