**Sub :: ACP Scheme for Railway Servants - clarification regarding**

Pursuant to the V CPC's recommendations, the entry grade of Dieticians on the Railways was revised to Rs.5500-9000 vide Board's letter No.PC-V/97/L/RSRP/1 dated 16.10.97. The issue of according adequate promotional avenue to the category of Dietician was under consideration of this Ministry for quite some time. In the background of ACP Scheme having been adopted on the Railways, the Ministry of Railways have now decided that the higher grades for the Dieticians have to be found through ACP Scheme. While the first financial upgradation of Dieticians will be to the standard grade of Rs.6500-10500, for second ACP, the grade of Rs.7500-12000, instead of the standard Gr. of Rs.7450-11500(RSRP) shall be available for the Dieticians, in accordance with specific recommendations of V CPC. As such, the Dieticians will be eligible for career progression in the following manner subject to all other terms and conditions laid down in Railway Board's letter No.PC-V/99/L/1/1 dated 1.10.99:-





पांचवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों के अनुसार, रेलों पर डाइटेरिशन के पंटी ग्रेड को बोर्ड के दिनांक 16.10.97 के पत्र सं० पीसी-5/97/आई/आरएसआरपी/1 के तहत संशोधित करके 5500-9000 ₹0 कर दिया गया था. डाइटेरिशन के कोट के लिए पर्याप्त पदोन्नति संभावनाओं से संबंधित मामला कुछ समय से इस मंत्रालय में विचारधीन था. रेलों पर अपनाई जा रही ए.सी.पी.योजना को पृष्ठभूमि में, रेल मंत्रालय ने अब विनिश्चय किया है कि डाइटेरिशन के लिए उच्चतर ग्रेड को ए.सी.पी. योजना के माध्यम से प्राप्त किया जाना है. हालांकि डाइटेरिशन का प्रथम वित्तीय अपग्रेडेशन दूसरे ए.सी.पी. के लिए 6500-10500 ₹0 के मानक ग्रेड के अनुसार होगा जबकि पांचवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की विनोर्टिफिड सिफारिशों के अनुसार डाइटेरिशन के लिए 7450-11500 ₹0 {आर.एस.आर.पी.} के मानक ग्रेड को बजाय 7500-12000 ₹0 का ग्रेड उपलब्ध होगा. इस प्रकार, डाइटेरिशन रेलवे बोर्ड के दिनांक 1.10.99 के पत्र सं० पीसी-5/99/आई/1/1 में निर्धारित अन्य सभी निबंधन और शर्तों के अधधीन निम्नलिखित प्रकार से कैरियर में पदोन्नति के लिए पात्र होंगे :-
