**Sub:-Admissibility of RSRP Rules, 1997 to the employees on sick leave on 01.01.96 and whose services had been terminated due to medical invalidation, without resuming their duty.**

The matter regarding applicability of RSRP Rules, 1997 to Railway servants who had been on sick leave on 01.01.96 and whose services had been terminated due to medical invalidation before they could resume their duty, had been under consideration in Board's office in consultation with Department of Personnel & Training and Ministry of Finance. It is clarified in this connection that in terms of Note 3 below Rule 7 of RSRP Rules, 1997, if a government servant was on leave on 1.1.96 the benefits of revised scales of pay are admissible to him from the date he resumes duty. In such cases the pay is required to be fixed in the revised scale on 1.1.96 on notional basis and actual benefit of pay allowed from the date of resuming duty. However, it has now been decided that in relaxation of Note 2 below Rule 6 of RSRP Rules, 1997, even those Railway servants who were on sick leave on 01.01.96 and had been retired subsequently on medical invalidation without resuming duty, would also be covered under Note 2 below Rule 6 of RSRP Rules, 1997 and they may be allowed the benefit of the revised pay.





विषय:- 1.1.96 को बीमारी की छुट्टी पर रहे कर्मचारियों और जिनकी सेवाएं उनके द्वारा कार्यभार ग्रहण किए बिना ही चिकित्सा अमान्यकरण के कारण समाप्त कर दी गई थी, को रेल सेवा संशोधित वेतनमान नियम, 1997 की स्वीकार्यता.

उन रेल कर्मचारियों, जो 1.1.96 को बीमारी की छुट्टी पर थे और जिनकी सेवाएं उनके द्वारा कार्यभार संभालने से पहले ही चिकित्सा अमान्यकरण के कारण समाप्त कर दी गई थी, को रेल सेवा संशोधित वेतनमान नियम, 1997 की स्वीकार्यता से संबंधित मामला कार्मिक एवं प्रशिक्षण विभाग और वित्त मंत्रालय के परामर्श से बोर्ड कार्यालय में विचाराधीन था. इस संबंध में यह स्पष्ट किया जाता है कि रेल सेवा संशोधित वेतनमान नियम, 1997 के नियम 7 के नीचे दिए गए नोट 3 के अनुसार, यदि कोई सरकारी कर्मचारी 1.1.96 को छुट्टी पर था तो उसे वेतन के संशोधित वेतनमानों का लाभ उस तारीख से स्वीकार्य होगा जिस तारीख से वह अपना कार्यभार ग्रहण करता है. ऐसे मामलों में वेतन नोशनल आधार पर 1.1.96 को संशोधित वेतनमान में निर्धारित किया जाना अपेक्षित है और वेतन के वास्तविक लाभ कार्यभार ग्रहण करने की तारीख से अनुमेय होंगे. बहरहाल, अब यह निश्चय किया गया है कि रेल सेवा संशोधित वेतनमान नियम, 1997 के नियम 6 के नीचे दिए गए नोट 2 में छूट देते हुए, उन रेल कर्मचारियों को भी जो 1.1.96 को बीमारी की छुट्टी पर थे और कार्यभार ग्रहण किए बिना ही चिकित्सा अमान्यकरण के कारण बाद में सेवानिवृत्त हो गए थे, रेल सेवा संशोधित वेतनमान नियम, 1997 के नियम 6 के नीचे दिए गए नोट 2 के अंतर्गत शामिल किया जाएगा और उन्हें भी संशोधित वेतन के लाभ की अनुमति दी जाए.
