**Sub: ACP scheme for Railway servants – clarification
regarding Physiotherapists.**

Pursuant to the V CPC's recommendations, the entry grade of Physiotherapists recruited with qualification of 10 + 2 or Higher Secondary and diploma in Physiotherapy (3 years) on the Railways was revised to Rs. 5500-9000 vide Board's letter No. PC-V/97/I/RSRP/1 dated 16.10.97. Further, an additional grade of Rs. 7500-12000 for this category was introduced vide Board's letter No. PC-V/97/I/11/12 dated 8.4.99. With the result, the existing hierarchy of the category of Physiotherapists now comprises of the following grades :

Physiotherapist Gr. II	Rs. 5500-9000
Physiotherapist Gr. I	Rs. 6500-10500
Assistant Physiotherapy Officer	Rs. 7500-12000

In the background of Assured Career Progression Scheme also having been adopted on the Railways, financial upgradation under the ACP scheme shall be to the next higher grade in accordance with the existing hierarchy in a category. As such the Physiotherapists in the grade Rs. 5500-9000 and in the grade Rs. 6500-10500 are eligible for career progression to the grades of Rs. 6500-10500 and 7500-12000 respectively under ACPS subject to all other terms and conditions prescribed in Railway Board's letter No. PC-V/99/I/1/1 dt. 1.10.99.



फिजियोथेरेपिस्टों के संबंध में स्पष्टीकरण.**


पांचवें केन्द्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों के अनुसरण में, रेलों पर 10+2 अथवा उच्चतर माध्यमिक उत्तीर्ण और फिजियोथेरेपी में डिप्लोमा (3 वर्ष) की योग्यता में भर्ती किए गए फिजियोथेरेपिस्टों के प्रारंभिक ग्रेड को बोर्ड के दिनांक 16.10.97 के पत्र सं. पीसी-V/97/आई/आर एस आर पी/1 के तहत संशोधित करके 5500-9000 रू. किया गया था. इसके अलावा, इस कोटि के लिए बोर्ड के दिनांक 8.4.99 के पत्र सं. पीसी-V/97/आई/11/12 के तहत 7500-12000 रू. का एक अतिरिक्त ग्रेड शुरू किया गया था. परिणामस्वरूप फिजियोथेरेपिस्टों की कोटि के मौजूदा पदानुक्रम में अब निम्नलिखित ग्रेड शामिल होंगे :-

फिजियोथेरेपिस्ट ग्रेड - II	5500-9000 रू.
फिजियोथेरेपिस्ट ग्रेड - I	6500-10500 रू.
सहायक फिजियोथेरेपी अधिकारी	7500-12000 रू.

सुनिश्चित कैरियर प्रोन्नति योजना को रेलों पर भी अपनाए जाने की पृष्ठभूमि में किसी कोटि के मौजूदा पदानुक्रम के अनुसार ए सी पी योजना के अंतर्गत वित्तीय अपग्रेडेशन अगले उच्चतर ग्रेड में होगा. इसलिए 5500-9000 रू. तथा 6500-10500 रू. के ग्रेड वाले फिजियोथेरेपिस्ट ए सी पी योजना के अंतर्गत क्रमशः 6500-10500 रू. तथा 7500-12000 रू. के ग्रेडों में कैरियर प्रोन्नति के पात्र हैं जो रेलवे बोर्ड के दिनांक 1.10.99 के पत्र सं. पीसी-V/99/आई/1/1 में निर्धारित अन्य निबंधनों और शर्तों के अधीन हैं.
