**Sub: Grant of advance increments to Stenographers in
Subordinate Offices for acquiring higher speed in
Shorthand.**

In accordance with the provisions contained in this Ministry's letter No. PC-IV/88/Increment/1 dated 27.10.89, Stenographers in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 1200-2040 were granted one or two advance increments respectively on their qualifying at 100 or 120 words per minute in shorthand both at the recruitment stage and while in service, which were not to be absorbed in future increments and the date of next increment after the grant of advance increments, remained the same.

2. Consequent upon the revision of pay scale w.e.f. 01.0.1996 on the recommendations of the Fifth Central Pay Commission, the matter relating to the revision of the rate of the advance increment(s) in respect of those Railway employees who had already qualified and were in receipt of advance increment(s) prior to 01.01.96 has been under consideration in consultation with Department of personnel & Training. The President is now pleased to decide that the rate of increment(s) in respect of those Railway employees who were already in receipt of advance increment(s) prior to 01.01.96 in terms of provisions contained in the letter dated 27.10.1989 referred to above, will be an amount equivalent to the lowest rate of increment in the revised scale corresponding to the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 1200-2040. It should be ensured that such employees have not already been given benefit of counting the advance increments towards pay fixation in terms of Rule 7(1)(B) of RSRP Rules, 1997.

3. The increment(s) granted on or after 01.01.96 in the revised scales will henceforth be termed as special allowances and will not count as pay for allowances and as emoluments for pension/gratuity.

4. These orders take effect from the date on which an employee draws pay in the revised scale of pay under the RSRP Rules, 1997.


विषय :- अधीनस्थ कार्यालयों के आशुलिपिकों को आशुलिपि में उच्चतर गति प्राप्त करने के लिए अग्रिम वेतन वृद्धि प्रदान करना.

इस मंत्रालय के दिनांक 27.10.89 के पत्र सं. पी सी-IV/88/इन्क्रीमेंट/1 में अंतर्विष्ट प्रावधानों के अनुसार, 1200-2040 रू. के संशोधन-पूर्व वेतनमान वाले आशुलिपिकों को भर्ती के समय और सेवा में रहते हुए आशुलिपि में 100 अथवा 120 शब्द प्रति मिनट की गति प्राप्त करने पर क्रमशः एक या दो अग्रिम वेतन वृद्धियां प्रदान की गई थीं, जिन्हें भावी वेतन वृद्धियों में समाहित नहीं किया जाना था और अग्रिम वेतन वृद्धियां प्रदान करने के पश्चात अगले वेतन वृद्धि की तारीख वही रहती.


2. पांचवें केन्द्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों के आधार पर 01.01.1996 से वेतनमानों में संशोधन के परिणामस्वरूप, वे रेल कर्मचारी, जो 01.01.96 से पहले अर्हक थे और अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धि प्राप्त कर रहे थे, उन्हें दी जा रही अग्रिम वेतन-वृद्धियों की दरों में संशोधन करने से संबंधित मामला कार्मिक और प्रशिक्षण विभाग के परामर्श से बोर्ड के विचाराधीन है. अब राष्ट्रपति जी ने सहर्ष विनिश्चय किया है कि दिनांक 27.10.1989 के उपर्युक्त पत्र में अन्तर्विष्ट प्रावधानों के अनुसार जो रेल कर्मचारी 01.01.1996 से पूर्व अग्रिम वेतन वृद्धियां प्राप्त कर रहे थे उनके लिए वेतन वृद्धि (वृद्धियों) की दर, 1200-2040 रू. के संशोधन पूर्व वेतनमान के तदनुरूपी संशोधित वेतनमान में वेतन वृद्धि की निम्नतम दर के समतुल्य राशि होगी. यह सुनिश्चित किया जाए कि ऐसे कर्मचारियों को, रेल सेवा संशोधित वेतनमान नियम 1997 के नियम 7(1) (बी) के अनुसार वेतन निर्धारण के समय इसको हिसाब में लेने का लाभ पहले न दिया गया हो.

3. 01.01.1996 को या इसके बाद संशोधित वेतनमान में प्रदान की गई वेतन वृद्धि (वेतन वृद्धियों) को अब से विशेष भत्ते के रूप में माना जाएगा और इसे भत्तों के लिए वेतन और पेंशन/ग्रेच्युटी के लिए परिलब्धियों के रूप में हिसाब में नहीं लिया जाएगा.

4. ये आदेश उस तारीख से प्रभावी होंगे जिस तारीख को कर्मचारी ने रे.से.सं.वे. नियम, 1997 के अंतर्गत संशोधित वेतनमान में वेतन प्राप्त किया है.
