**Sub: Adjustment of two advance increments granted to
Constables in RPF/RPSF.**

The RPF/RPSF Constables who had been in the IV CPC scale of Rs. 825-15-900-EB-20-1200 + two advance increments had been granted the scale of Rs. 2750-70-3800-75-4400 + two advance increments w.e.f. 01.01.96 vide Railway Board's letter No. PC-V/97/RSRP/1 dated 16.10.97. The matter regarding treatment of the advance increments has been under examination in Board's office in consultation with Department of Personnel & Training.

2. It has now been decided that on electing to come over to revised scales the pay of the constables in RPF/RPSF be fixed with reference to the pay in the pre-revised scale (reckoned in the manner indicated in para 2.1. below) and then two advance increments granted again in the revised scale.

2.1. In the case of those Constables who had received upto two advance increments at the time of fixation in IV CPC scales, their pay should be fixed with reference to the pay in the pre-revised scale, excluding the quantum of advance increments enjoyed by them as on 01.01.96. For others, who did not receive the benefit of advance increments, no such adjustment in the pay in pre-revised scale would be necessary.

3. After the pay is fixed in the revised scale (V CPC), two advance increments could be granted in the revised scale. The benefit of two advance increments would be granted during the period between 01.01.96 to 09.10.97. Thereafter, the pay scale of Constables in RPF/RPSF would be fixed in the scale of Rs. 3050-75-3950-80-4590 as allotted vide Railway Board's order dated 04.12.97.


विषय: रे.सु.ब./रे.सु.वि.ब. में कांस्टेबलों को प्रदान की गई दो अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियों का समायोजन

रेल सुरक्षा बल/रे.सु.वि.ब. के कांस्टेबल जिन्हें चौथे केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग का 825-15-900-ईबी-20-1200 रुपये का वेतनमान + दो अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियां प्रदान की गई थी, को रेलवे बोर्ड के दिनांक 16.10.97 के पत्र सं. पी सी -V/97/ आई/आर एस आर पी /1 द्वारा 1.1.96 से 2750-70-3800-75-4400 का वेतनमान - दो वेतनवृद्धियां प्रदान की गई थी। अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियों के प्रतिपादन से संबंधित मामले की कार्मिक एवं प्रशिक्षण विभाग के परामर्श से बोर्ड कार्यालय में जांच की जा रही है।

2. अब यह विनिश्चय किया गया है कि चयन होने पर संशोधित वेतनमान में आने के लिए रेल सुरक्षा बल/रे.सु.वि.ब. के कांस्टेबलों का वेतन संशोधन पूर्व वेतनमान में वेतन के संदर्भ में निर्धारित किया जाए (नीचे पैग 2.1 में दिए गये तरीके से गणना की जाए) तथा फिर संशोधित वेतनमान में फिर से दो अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियां प्रदान की जाएं।

2.1 उन कांस्टेबलों के मामले में जो चौथे केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग के वेतनमानों में वेतन निर्धारण के समय दो अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियां ले रहे थे, का वेतन 1.1.96 को उनके द्वारा ली जानेवाली अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियों की मात्रा को छोड़कर संशोधन-पूर्व-वेतनमान में वेतन के अनुसार निर्धारित किया जाय। अन्य कांस्टेबलों के मामले में जो अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियों के लाभ नहीं ले रहे थे, संशोधन पूर्व वेतनमान में वेतन का ऐसा समायोजन आवश्यक नहीं होगा।

3. संशोधित वेतनमान में वेतन के बाद, संशोधित (पांचवे केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग) वेतनमान में दो अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियां प्रदान की जा सकती है। दो अग्रिम वेतनवृद्धियों का लाभ 1.1.96 से 9.10.97 के बीच की अवधि के दौरान प्रदान किया जाएगा। उसके बाद, रेल सुरक्षा बल/रे.सु.वि.ब. के कांस्टेबलों का वेतनमान रेलवे बोर्ड के दिनांक 4.12.97 के आदेश द्वारा 3050-75-3950-80-4590 रु. के वेतनमान में निर्धारित किया जाएगा।
