**Sub: Financial Upgradation under the ACP Scheme -
Clarification regarding.**


Please refer to Board's letter of even number dated 1.10.1999 regarding the Assured Career progression Scheme (ACPS) and subsequent amendments/clarifications that have been issued from time to time.

2. The issue regarding grant of financial upgradation under the ACP Scheme to the retired/died/resigned railway employees by waiving the condition of passing trade test/suitability test/selection for them was under consideration for sometime. The item has also been taken up by AIRF in the forum of PNM.

3. The matter has been examined in consultation with the DoP&T. It has been decided that as a very special case, the requirement of passing the trade test/skill test for the purpose of grant of ACP Scheme may be waived in respect of those employees who were in service as on the date of introduction of the ACP Scheme but had retired/died/resigned prior to holding of first trade test/ skill test for the purpose of grant of benefit under ACPS after introduction of the Scheme.

4. The above relaxation is, however, subject to the condition that an assessment of suitability for promotion of such employees including skill competence at the relevant time is made in some other manner such as on the basis of assessment report etc. The requirement of clearing the trade test/skill test/departmental examination etc. even for grant of ACPS, where prescribed for regular promotion, will continue to be applicable in other cases.


विषय : ए सी पी योजना के अंतर्गत वित्तीय अपग्रेडेशन के संबंध में स्पष्टीकरण.

कृपया सुनिश्चित कैरियर प्रोन्नयन योजना (ए सी पी एस) के संबंध में बोर्ड के 1.10.1999 के समसंख्यक पत्र तथा बाद में किए गए संशोधनों/स्पष्टीकरणों जिन्हें समय-समय पर जारी किया गया है, का अवलोकन करें.

2. सेवानिवृत्त/मृत/त्याग-पत्र दिए रेल कर्मचारियों के लिए ट्रेड परीक्षा/उपयुक्तता परीक्षण/चयन पास करने की शर्त में छूट देते हुए, उन्हें ए सी पी योजना के अंतर्गत वित्तीय अपग्रेडेशन प्रदान करने संबंधी मामला काफी समय से विचाराधीन था. स्थायी वार्ता तंत्र के मंच से ए आई आर एफ द्वारा भी इस मद को उठाया गया है.

3. कार्मिक एवं प्रशिक्षण विभाग के परामर्श से इस मामले की जांच की गई है. यह विनिश्चय किया गया है कि एक अत्यंत विशेष मामले के रूप में, ए सी पी योजना प्रदान करने के प्रयोजन के लिए ट्रेड परीक्षा/कुशलता जांच पास करने की आवश्यकता को उन कर्मचारियों के संबंध में छूट दी जाए जो ए सी पी योजना लागू करने की तारीख को सेवा में थे परंतु इस योजना के लागू होने के बाद ए सी पी योजना के अंतर्गत वह लाभ प्रदान करने के प्रयोजन के लिए प्रथम ट्रेड परीक्षा/कुशलता जांच आयोजित करने से पूर्व ही सेवानिवृत्त हो गए थे/मृत्यु हो गई थी/त्यागपत्र दे दिया था.

4. लेकिन, उपयुक्त छूट इस शर्त के अधीन है कि ऐसे कर्मचारियों की पदोन्नति के लिए संबद्ध समय पर उनकी कुशलता-राक्षमता सहित उनकी उपयुक्तता का आकलन किसी अन्य तरीके जैसे आकलन रिपोर्ट आदि के आधार पर लगाया जाए. ए सी पी योजना प्रदान करने के लिए भी ट्रेड परीक्षा/कुशलता जांच/विभागीय परीक्षा आदि पास करने की आवश्यकता जहाँ नियमित पदोन्नति के लिए निर्धारित है, अन्य मामलों में लागू रहेगी.
