**Sub: Merger of 50% of Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief with Basic Pay/Pension to Central Government employees - Clarification regarding.**  
**Ref: Board's letter of even number dated 11-3-2004**

Pursuant to the Board's letter mentioned above, references have been received seeking clarifications on certain aspects regarding inclusion of Dearness Pay for various purposes. In this regard, following clarifications are furnished:

- All allowances such as Dual Charge Allowance, Subsistence Allowance, Teaching allowance etc which were hitherto being calculated on the basis of the Basic Pay will be calculated on Basic Pay plus Dearness Pay. However, Overtime Allowance (OTA), which is presently payable with respect to IV CPC scales shall continue to be regulated with respect to such scales.
- Dearness Pay shall be variable consequent upon increase or decrease of Basic Pay in the event of annual increment, promotion, punishment etc.
- Amount to be recovered at the time of retirement towards CGHS/RELHS shall be calculated on the basis of Basic Pay plus Dearness Pay.

बोर्ड के उपर्युक्त पत्र के अनुसरण में, विभिन्न प्रयोजनों के लिए मंहगाई वेतन को शामिल करने के संबंध में कतिपय पहलुओं पर स्पष्टीकरण के लिए पत्र प्राप्त हुए हैं। इस संबंध में, निम्नलिखित स्पष्टीकरण दिए जा रहे हैं:-

(क) दोहरा कार्यभार भत्ता, निर्वाह भत्ता, शिक्षण भत्ता आदि जैसे सभी भत्ते जिनकी इससे पहले मूल वेतन के आधार पर गणना की जाती थी, अब मूल वेतन जमा मंहगाई वेतन के आधार पर की जाएगी। लेकिन, समयोपरि भत्ता जो इस समय चौथे केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग के वेतनमानों के अनुसार देय है, इन्हीं वेतनमानों के अनुसार ही विनिर्गमित किया जाता रहेगा।

(ख) मंहगाई वेतन वार्षिक वेतनवृद्धि, पदोन्नति, दंड आदि की दशा में मूल वेतन में वृद्धि या कमी होने के परिणामस्वरूप परिवर्तित होता रहेगा।

(ग) सेवानिवृत्ति के समय के.स.स्वा.योजना/आर ई एल एच एस के लिए वसूल की जाने वाली राशि की गणना मूल वेतन जमा मंहगाई वेतन के आधार पर की जाएगी।
