Sub : Payment of Dearness Allowance to Railway employees - Revised Rates effective from 1.7.2004.

Please refer to Board's letter of even number dated 12.3.2004 (S.No.PC-V/401, RBE No. 58/2004) on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Allowance payable to Railway employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 11% to 14% with effect from 1st July, 2004.

2. The provisions contained in Paras 3 and 4 of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 16.10.1997 (S.No.PC-V/3, RBE No.139/97) shall continue to be applicable, while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders. However, with effect from 01.04.2004, Dearness Allowance will be computed on the basis of Basic Pay, Dearness Pay, Stagnation Increment and NPA. Provisions contained in para 3 of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 16.10.1997 therefore stand amended to this extent.

3. The additional instalment of Dearness Allowance payable under these orders shall be paid in cash to all Railway employees. The arrears may be charged to the salary bill for October 2004, and no honorarium is payable for preparing separate bill for this purpose.

4. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fraction of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and the fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

विषय : रेल कर्मचारियों को महंगाई भत्ते की अदायगी - संशोधित दरें
01.07.2004 से लागू.

उपर्युक्त विषय पर इस मंत्रालय के 12.3.2004 के समसंख्यक पत्र (क्रम संख्या पी. सी.V/401 आर बी ई सं. 58/2004) का हवाला देने तथा यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि राष्ट्रपति ने रेल कर्मचारियों को मिलने वाले महंगाई भत्ते की मौजूदा दर को 1 जुलाई 2004 से 11 प्रतिशत से बढ़ाकर 14 प्रतिशत करने का निर्णय लिया है.

2. इस मंत्रालय के 16.10.97 के समसंख्यक पत्र (क्रम संख्या पी. सी.V/3, आर.बी. ई. सं. 139/97) के पैरा 3 और 4 में अंतर्विष्ट उपबंध इन आदेशों के अन्तर्गत महंगाई भत्ता विनियमित करते समय लागू रहेंगे. तथापि 1.4.2004 से प्रभावी महंगाई भत्ते का परिकल्पन मूल वेतन, महंगाई वेतन, गतिरोध वेतन वृद्धि और एन पी ए के आधार पर किया जाएगा. इस मंत्रालय के 16.10.1997 के समसंख्यक पत्र के पैरा 3 में निहित उपबंधों को इस सीमा तक संशोधित किया जाता है.

3. इन आदेशों के तहत देय महंगाई भत्ते की अतिरिक्त किस्त का भुगतान समस्त रेल कर्मचारियों को नकद रूप में किया जाएगा. बकाया राशि अक्टूबर, 2004 के वेतन बिल में प्रभारित की जाए. इस प्रयोजन के लिए अलग से बिल बनाने के लिए किसी मानदेय का भुगतान नहीं किया जाएगा.

4. महंगाई भत्ते के कारण की जाने वाली जिस अदायगी में 50 पैसे अथवा उससे अधिक पैसे हों उसे अगले रूपए पर पूर्णांकित किया जाएगा और 50 पैसे से कम की रकम को छोड़ दिया जाएगा.
