Sub: Grant of pay scale of Rs 5000-8000 to the category of Haemodialysis Technicians and Cardiac Cath. Lab. Technicians in the Railways.

The issue of grant of appropriate pay scale to the category of Haemodialysis Technicians and Cardiac Cath. Lab. Technicians in the Railways has been under consideration of the Board.

2. The matter has been considered and it has been decided to grant the pay scale of Rs.5000-8000 to the category of Haemodialysis Technicians and Cardiac Cath. Lab. Technicians in the Railways. For these two categories, it has also been decided that the undermentioned qualification/experience should be prescribed for future recruitments:


(a) Haemo-Dialysis Technicians: B.Sc. plus Diploma in Haemo-Dialysis/or two years' satisfactory in-house training/experience in hemo-dialysis work in a reputed institution.

(b) Cardiac Cath. Lab. Technicians: Degree in Science plus Diploma from a reputed Cardiac Lab in cardiac profusion/Cath. Lab work or two years' in-house training/experience in a reputed cardiac cath. lab.

3. The new pay scale shall be effective from the date of issue of these orders.

4. The existing staff who are working in a lower scale than Rs.5000-8000 will get the benefit of the higher scale of Rs.5000-8000 provided they possess the requisite qualification. The existing staff who are working in the scale Rs.5000-8000 or a higher scale and do not possess the requisite qualification will continue to get the benefit of the higher scale as personal to them till the posts are vacated by them. Once the posts are vacated, they will revert to the scale Rs.5000-8000 from the date such posts fall vacant.

विषय : रेलों में हीमोयोडाइलिसिस तकनीशियनों एवं कार्डिअक कैथ लैब तकनीशियनों की कोटियों को 5000-8000/- रु. का वेतनमान प्रदान करना.

रेलों में हीमोयोडाइलिसिस तकनीशियनों एवं कार्डिअक कैथ लैब तकनीशियनों की कोटि को उपयुक्त वेतनमान प्रदान करने का मुद्दा बोर्ड के विचाराधीन रहा है.

2. इस मामले की जांच की गई है और रेलों में हीमोयोडाइलिसिस तकनीशियनों एवं कार्डिअक कैथ लैब तकनीशियनों की कोटि को 5000-8000/- रु. का वेतनमान प्रदान करने का विनिश्चय किया गया है. इन दो कोटियों के लिए यह भी विनिश्चय किया गया है कि भविष्य में भर्ती के लिए निम्नलिखित अर्हता/अनुभव निर्धारित किया जाए :-

(क) हीमोयोडाइलिसिस तकनीशियन: उम्मीदवार को बी एस सी/हीमोयोडाइलिसिस में डिप्लोमा /अथवा किसी ख्याति प्राप्त संस्थान में हीमोयोडाइलिसिस में संतोषजनक दो वर्ष का इन-हाउस प्रशिक्षण/अनुभव होना चाहिए.

(ख) कार्मिक कैथ लैब तकनीशियन : उम्मीदवार को विज्ञान में डिग्री और कार्डिअक प्रोफ्यूजर/कैथ लैब संबंधी कार्यों में किसी ख्याति प्राप्त कार्डिअक लैब से डिप्लोमा अथवा किसी ख्याति प्राप्त कार्डिअक कैथ लैब में दो वर्ष का इन-हाउस प्रशिक्षण/अनुभव होना चाहिए.

3. नए वेतनमान इन आदेशों के जारी होने की तारीख से लागू होंगे.

4. मौजूदा कर्मचारी जो 5000-8000/- रु. के कम वेतनमान में कार्यरत हैं, वे 5000-8000/- रु. का उच्च वेतनमान का लाभ प्राप्त करेंगे बशर्ते वे अपेक्षित अर्हता रखते हों. मौजूदा कर्मचारी जो 5000-8000/- रु. के वेतनमान अथवा उच्च वेतनमान में कार्यरत हैं और अपेक्षित अर्हता नहीं रखते, वे उनके द्वारा पदों को रिक्त किए जाने तक स्वीकृत उच्च वेतनमान का लाभ पाते रहेंगे. एक बार पद रिक्त होने पर, ऐसे पदों को उनके रिक्त होने की तारीख से 5000-8000/- रु. के वेतनमान में वापस कर दिया जाएगा.
