**Sub:- Zonal Railway status of RDSO – Recommendations of the
Restructuring Committee of RDSO – Stenographers.**

Consequent to the revised status of RDSO as a Zonal Railway it has been decided that instructions contained in Board's letter No. PC-V/99/I/9/1 dated 28.9.99 (RBE No. 225/99, S.No. PC-V/213) and PC-V/97/R-II/48 dated 15.9.2000 (RBE No. 165/2000, S.No. PC-V/279) regarding pay scales of Stenographers are applicable to RDSO also on prospective basis from the date of such revision in the status of RDSO.

2. The existing incumbents of the posts in grade Rs. 10000-15200 will continue in the scale Rs.10000-15200 on personal basis till the vacation of the posts by them. On vacation of the post, it will be operated in the grade Rs. 8000-13500. The posts of Stenographers in the grade of Rs. 7500-12000 accruing out of Board's letter No. PC-V/97/R-II/48 dated 15.9.2000 will be operated for the coordinating HODs in RDSO on regular basis. With the introduction of grade structure to the cadre of Stenographers at par with that of Zonal Railways /PUs, the recruitment and promotion rules as applicable to Zonal Railways would be applicable to the stenographic cadre of RDSO also.



समिति की सिफारिशें - आशुलिपिक

अ.अ.मा.सं. को क्षेत्रीय रेल का संशोधित दर्जा दिए जाने के परिणामस्वरूप, यह विनिश्चय किया गया है कि आशुलिपिकों के वेतनमान के संबंध में बोर्ड के 28.9.99 के पत्र सं. पी सी-V/99/आई/9/1 (आर बी ई सं.225/99, क्र.सं. पी सी-V/213) तथा 15.9.2000 के पी. सी. V/97/आर-II/48 (आर बी ई सं.165/2000, क्र.सं. पी सी V/279) में समाविष्ट अनुदेश अ.अ.मा.सं. के दर्जे में संशोधन किए जाने की तारीख से भविष्यलक्षी आधार पर अ.अ.मा.सं. पर भी लागू है.

2. 10000-15200/- रु. के ग्रेड में तैनात मौजूदा पदधारियों द्वारा इन पदों को खाली किए जाने तक वे वैयक्तिक आधार पर 10000-15200/- रु. के ग्रेड में बने रहेंगे. इन पदों के खाली होने पर इन्हें 8000-13500/- रु. के ग्रेड में परिचालित किया जाएगा. बोर्ड के 15.9.2000 के पत्र सं. पी सी-V/97/आर-II/48 से प्रोद्भूत होने वाले 7500-12000/- रु. के ग्रेड में आशुलिपिकों के पद नियमित आधार पर अ.अ.मा.सं. में समन्वयकारी विभागाध्यक्षों के लिए परिचालित किए जाएंगे. क्षेत्रीय रेलों/उत्पादन इकाइयों के समान आशुलिपिकों के संवर्ग में ग्रेड संरचना प्रारंभ करने से, क्षेत्रीय रेलों में यथा लागू भर्ती तथा पदोन्नति नियम अ.अ.मा.सं. के आशुलिपिकीय संवर्ग में भी लागू होंगे.
