Sub:- Assured Career Progression (ACP) Scheme for the Railway servants – Clarification regarding non-empanelment of an employee after passing normal selection.

Please refer to Board's letter of even number dated 1.10.1999 regarding the Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACPS) and subsequent amendments/clarifications that have been issued from time to time.

2. The NFIR had raised the issue relating to cases where an employee, who passed the normal selection but could not be empanelled/promoted due to shortage of vacancy and was asked to appear again for selection for ACP. The matter has since been examined and it has been decided that an employee, who has passed the normal selection but could not be finally empanelled only because of paucity of vacancies, may be exempted from reappearing in the selection for ACP. However, an employee, who has passed selection for ACP, would again be required to go through the process of selection at the time of his normal promotion as per extant instructions.

2. एन एफ आई आर ने उन मामलों, जिनमें किसी कर्मचारी, जिसने साधारण चयन पास किया था परंतु रिक्ति के अभाव के कारण पैनलबद्ध/पदोन्नत नहीं किया जा सका था और जिसे सुनिश्चित कैरियर प्रोन्नयन योजना के लिए चयन के लिए पुनः उपस्थित होने के लिए कहा गया था, से संबंधित मुद्दा उठाया था. इस मामले की अब जांच की गई है और यह विनिश्चय किया गया है कि उस कर्मचारी को, जिसने साधारण चयन पास किया था परंतु रिक्तियों की कमी के कारण ही अंतिम रूप से पैनलबद्ध नहीं किया जा सका था, सुनिश्चित कैरियर प्रोन्नयन योजना के लिए चयन में पुनः उपस्थित होने से छूट दी जाए. लेकिन, उस कर्मचारी को जिसने सुनिश्चित कैरियर प्रोन्नयन योजना की चयन परीक्षा पास की है उसे मौजूदा अनुदेशों के अनुसार अपनी साधारण पदोन्नति के समय पुनः चयन की प्रक्रिया से होकर गुजरना अपेक्षित होगा.


