In continuation of Ministry of Railways letter of even number dated 13.6.2002 (S.No.PC-V/344, RBE No.84/2002) revising the rate of Dearness Allowance w.e.f. 1.1.2002 in respect of Railway servants who continue to draw their pay and emoluments in the pre-revised scale of pay, the revised rate of Dearness Allowance w.e.f. 1.7.2002, 1.1.2003, 1.7.2003, 1.1.2004 & 1.7.2004 would be as follows:-


