**Sub: Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme (MACPS) for the Railways  
Employees-Clarifications Regarding.**

Reference is invited to the Board's letter of even number dated 10.06.2009 regarding the Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme (MACPS). Consequent upon the implementation of Sixth Pay Commissions recommendations, the four pre-revised Group 'D' pay scales viz., Rs.2550-3200, Rs.2610-3540, Rs.2610-4000 and Rs.2650-4000 have been upgraded and replaced by the revised pay structure of grade pay of Rs.1800 in the pay band PB-1. As per the recommendations of Sixth CPC, Railway servants in these four pre-revised Group 'D' scales have been granted the Group 'C' revised pay structure of grade pay of Rs.1800 in the pay band PB-1. It has been decided on the analogy of para-5 of the Annexure to Board's letter dated 10.06.2009 *ibid* that promotions earned or upgradations granted under ACP Scheme of 01.10.1999 in the past to the four pay scales mentioned above, which now carry the grade pay of Rs.1800/- shall be ignored for the purpose of MACPS. However, promotions/financial upgradations earned by existing Group 'D' employees to grade pay of Rs.1900 (pre-revised scales of Rs.3050-75-3590-80-4590) shall be counted for the purpose of MACPS.

(एमएसीपीएस) के संबंध में स्पष्टीकरण।**

आशोधित सुनिश्चित कैरियर प्रोन्नयन योजना के संबंध में बोर्ड के 10.06.2009 के समसंख्यक पत्र की ओर ध्यान आकर्षित किया जाता है। छठे केन्द्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों के कार्यान्वयन के परिणामस्वरूप, 2550-3200/- रुपए, 2610-3540/- रुपए, 2610-4000/- रुपए एवं 2650-4000/- रुपए के चार संशोधन पूर्व समूह 'घ' वेतनमानों को अपग्रेड किया गया है और पे बैंड पीबी-1 में 1800/- रुपए के ग्रेड पे के संशोधित वेतन ढांचे में रखा गया है। छठे केन्द्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों के अनुसार, इन चार संशोधन पूर्व समूह 'घ' वेतनमानों में रेल सेवकों को पे बैंड पीबी-1 में 1800/- रुपए के ग्रेड पे का समूह 'ग' संशोधित वेतन ढांचा प्रदान किया गया है। बोर्ड के उपर्युक्त 10.06.2009 के पत्र के अनुबंध-1 के पैरा-5 के समान विगत में उपर्युक्त चार वेतनमानों, जो अब 1800/- रुपए के ग्रेड पे में है, में प्राप्त पदोन्नतियों को अथवा 01.10.1999 को एसीपी योजना के अंतर्गत प्रदान किए गए अपग्रेडेशनों की एमएसीपीएस के प्रयोजन हेतु अनदेखी की जाएगी। बहरहाल, 1900/- रुपए (3050-75-3590-80-4590/- रुपए के संशोधन पूर्व वेतनमानों) के ग्रेड पे में मौजूदा समूह 'घ' कर्मचारियों द्वारा प्राप्त पदोन्नतियां/वित्तीय अपग्रेडेशनों की एमएसीपीएस के प्रयोजन हेतु गणना की जाएगी।

2. इसे रेल मंत्रालय के वित्त निदेशालय की सहमति से जारी किया जा रहा है।
