





**विषय :** सातवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों पर सरकार के निर्णय का क्रियान्वयन - 2016 से पूर्व के निःशक्तता पेंशनभोगियों की निःशक्तता पेंशन में संशोधन पर स्पष्टीकरण के संबंध में।

अधोहस्ताक्षरी को यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि सातवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों पर सरकार के निर्णय के अनुसरण में इस विभाग के दिनांक 4.8.2016 के कार्यालय जापन सं. 38/37/2016-पी एंड पी डब्ल्यू (ए) (II) द्वारा 2016 से पूर्व के निःशक्तता पेंशनभोगियों की निःशक्तता पेंशन में संशोधन के आदेश जारी किए गए थे। दिनांक 4.8.2016 के उपर्युक्त कार्यालय जापन के पैरा 4.1 के अनुसार, मौजूदा पेंशन/कुटुंब पेंशन को 2.57 से गुणा किया जाए और तदनुसार प्राप्त संशोधित पेंशन की धनराशि को अगले पूर्ण रुपए में परिवर्तित कर दिया जाए। कार्यालय जापन के पैरा 4.4 में यह उल्लेख किया गया है कि पेंशन और कुटुंब पेंशन की अधिकतम सीमा क्रमशः सरकार में अधिकतम वेतन अर्थात् 2,50,000/- रुपए का 50% और 30% होगी।

2. यह संदेह व्यक्त किया गया है कि क्या उक्त अधिकतम सीमा केंद्रीय सिविल सेवा (असाधारण पेंशन) नियमावली के अंतर्गत निःशक्तता पेंशन/कुटुंब पेंशन पर भी लागू होगी। केंद्रीय सिविल सेवा (असाधारण पेंशन) नियमावली के अंतर्गत निःशक्तता पेंशन/कुटुंब पेंशन गणना, अंतिम आहरित वेतन या पिछले 10 महीनों की औसत प्राप्तियों के क्रमशः 50% और 30% की दर से, जो भी पेंशनभोगी/कुटुंब पेंशनभोगी के लिए लाभदायक हो, के आधार पर की जाती है। निःशक्तता घटक के कारण केंद्रीय सिविल सेवा (असाधारण पेंशन) नियमावली के अंतर्गत निःशक्तता पेंशन/कुटुंब पेंशन, अंतिम आहरित वेतन या औसत प्राप्तियों के क्रमशः 50% और 30% से अधिक होती है। अतः यह स्पष्ट किया जाता है कि पेंशन और पेंशनभोगी कल्याण विभाग के दिनांक 4.8.2016 के कार्यालय जापन के पैरा 4.4 में उल्लिखित पेंशन और कुटुंब पेंशन की अधिकतम सीमा, केवल केंद्रीय सिविल सेवा (पेंशन) नियमावली के अंतर्गत पेंशन/कुटुंब पेंशन के मामले में लागू होगी, और केंद्रीय सिविल सेवा (असाधारण पेंशन) नियमावली के अंतर्गत निःशक्तता पेंशन/कुटुंब पेंशन के मामले में लागू नहीं होगी।

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject:** Implementation of Government's decision on the recommendations of the Seventh Central Pay Commission - -- Revision of disability pension of pre - 2016 disability pensioners - clarification regarding.

The undersigned is directed to say that in pursuance of Government's decision on the recommendations of Seventh Central Pay Commission, orders have been issued for revision of pension and disability pension of pre 2016 pensioners/disability pensioners, vide this Department's OM No. 38/37/2016-P&PW(A)(ii) dated 4.8.2016. As per para 4.1. of the OM dated 4.8.2016, the existing pension/family pension is to be multiplied by 2.57 and the amount of revised pension/family pension so arrived at shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee. As per para 4.4. of the OM, it was indicated that the upper ceiling of pension and family pension will be 50% and 30% respectively of the highest pay in the Government, i.e. Rs..2,50,000/-

2. A doubt has been raised whether the above ceiling would also be applicable to disability pension/family pension under CCS(EOP)Rules. Pension/family pension under CCS(Pension)Rules is calculated @50%/30%of the last pay drawn or average emoluments for last 10 months, whichever is more beneficial to the pensioner/family pensioner. Disability pension and family pension, under CCS(EOP)Rules is more than 50%/30%of last pay/average emoluments on account of the disability element. Therefore, it is clarified that the ceiling of pension/family pension indicated in para 4.4 of Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare OM dated 04.08.2016 referred to above is applicable only in the case of pension/family pension under CCS(Pension) Rules and will not apply in the case of disability pension/family pension under CCS(EOP) Rules.
