



- **⇒** 430.17 km new line added
- ⇒ 893.82 km gauge conversion done
- ⇒ 429.08 km double line added
- **⇒** 1399.35 RKM electrification completed
- **⊃** Survey of 1,578 km new line completed

- ⇒ Provided free high-speed WiFi at 385 nominated stations
- ⇒ Provided 41 Lifts at 15 stations and 02 more to be provided at Barsoi station
- ⇒ Provided 31 Escalators at 9 stations and 04 more to be provided at Kamakhya and Agartala (02 each) stations
- **⇒** Solar Power panels of capacity 5721.233 KWp installed
- ⇒ 53 nos of New Goods sheds opened
- ⇒ 13 nos of New Goods siding opened
- ⇒ 72 nos of on going Freight Terminals
- ⇒ 40 pairs of trains converted to LHB from conventional
- → During 2021-22 Fire Extinguisher was provided in 378 Non-AC coaches and thus completed in all targeted 1300 coaches
- ➡ Run longest journey Train No. 15906/05 between Dibrugarh and Kanyakumari Vivek Express
- ⇒ Run longest Rajdhani Train No. 20503/04 between Dibrugarh and New Delhi
- ⇒ Run longest Rajdhani with Tejas Train No. 20501/02 between Agartala and Anand Vihar Terminal
- **⇒** Run 5 nos of Vistadome Services to promote tourism




DEVELOPMENTAL WORKS IN ASSAM (2014 – 2024)

CONNECTIVITY ENHANCEMENT

- On 7th April, 2014, Naharlagun (Arunachal Pradesh) got connected by broad gauge line to Harmuti (Assam)
- → A first ever train connectivity established with Meghalaya on 29th November, 2014 when Dudhnoi (Assam) got connected by broad gauge line to Mendipathar (Meghalaya)
- **⊃** Broad Gauge train connectivity with Jiribam in Manipur from Arunachal (Assam) established on 27th May, 2016
- ⇒ Broad Gauge train connectivity with Bairabi in Mizoram from Katakhal (Assam) established on 27th May, 2016
- 212.59 km (Track Kilometer) of New Broad Gauge railway lines commissioned during 2014-23.
 Out of this 212.59 km, 82.84 km was part of 289 km long Maynaguri Jogighopa New Line project

- The Maynaguri-Golakganj-Jogighopa new broad gauge railway line provides an alternative link to the landlocked state of Assam and six other NE states and ensures uninterrupted connectivity
- ⇒ 212.16 km of Doubling of **Broad Gauge line** between New Bongaigaon Abhayapuri, Pancharatna Dudhnoi and Digaru Lumding section was achieved during 2014-22. of this 46.8 km was achieved in 2021-22
- ⇒ The doubling of section from New Bongaigaon to Azara has been completed as a part of the New Bongaigaon – Kamakhya via Goalpara 176 km double line project. Only the 13.1 km section from Azara to Kamakhya is left
- → Gauge Conversion carried out in 665.60 km from 2014-24 thereby eliminating all metre gauge railway lines in Assam
- → Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi virtually flagged off the first Vande Bharat Express of Assam connecting Guwahati to New Jalpaiguri on 29th May, 2023



BOGIBEEL BRIDGE COMMISSIONED

Bogibeel bridge near Dibrugarh opened for public on 25th December, 2018

- Longest Rail-cum-Road bridge in Asia
- **⊃** Reduced the distance from Upper Assam to Delhi by 170 km
- ➡ Fully welded, rivet free girders
- State of the art construction technology used

Key Benefits

- Fulfilled a long time strategic need for rail connectivity across Brahmaputra in Upper Assam
- The thrust is for creating additional infrastructure quickly for benefit of maximum number of people

NEW RAILWAY PROJECTS SANCTIONED IN 2014-24

- **○** 62 km new broad gauge line from Sivasagar to Jorhat at a cost of Rs. 2,696 crore
- ⇒ 99 km new broad gauge line from Salona to Khumtai at a cost of Rs. 5,958 crore

Key Benefits

- Create an alternative route to Upper Assam from Chaparmukh along NH 37
- Distance to Dibrugarh from Guwahati will be reduced
- Vast areas of Golaghat, Jorhat and Sibsagar districts will get connected
- ⇒ 25 km new broad gauge line from Tezpur to Silghat with a bridge over Brahmaputra at a cost of Rs. 3,512 crore

- Fourth bridge over Brahmaputra to connect Tezpur in north bank with Silghat in south bank
- Open up new route to Upper Assam from Tezpur
- Second Rail cum Road Bridge at Sarighat will create additional capacity for both inward and outward rail traffic apart form generating huge employment opportunities
- → 7 km new broad gauge line from Agthori to Kamakhya with Second Rail cum Road Bridge at Saraighat at a cost of Rs. 1,650 crore
- **⊃** 10 km four lane elevated lines from Kamakhya to New Guwahati at a cost of Rs. 6,124 crore
- ⇒ 26 km Murkongselek Pasighat new Broad Gauge line at a cost of Rs. 413 crore
- ⇒ 176 km Bongaigaon Goalpara Guwahati Doubling at a cost of Rs. 2,950 crore
- ⇒ 143 km New Bogaigaon Agthori (via Rangiya) Doubling at a cost of Rs. 2,043 crore
- ⇒ 381 km Lumding Tinsukia Jn- Dibrugarh Doubling at a cost of Rs. 3,810 crore
- Doubling of Broad Guage line between New Bongaigaon to Azara via Goalpara Town and Digaru-Lumding were achieved during 2014-24

SOME MAJOR SURVEYS FOR NEW BROAD GAUGE LINES

Surveys are going on for construction of 851 km of new Broad Gauge railway lines

- **○** 140 km from Rangiya to Dekargaon via Bezera, Sipajhar, Mangaldoi, Dalgaon, Orang
- ⇒ 100 km from Gogamukh to Jorhat via Dhakuakhana, Kamalabari and Garmur

Key Benefits

- Major untouched areas of Darrang district will be connected to railway map providing a large number of people means of economic travel
- Majuli, the world's largest river island, will be connected with railway line to both north bank and south bank of river Brahmaputra
- ⇒ 87 km from North Lakhimpur to Bame in Arunachal Pradesh via Silapathar
- ⇒ 75 km from Lekhapani to Deban via Nampong, New Khamlang
- ⇒ 96 km from Dumduma to Wakro via Simulguri, Namsi and Chowkham
- **○** 60 km from Dangri to Roing
- ⇒ 300 km from Tinsukia to Pasighat via Deomali, Lekhapani, Jairampur, Kharsang, Miao, Diyun, Tezu, Roing and Dambuk.
- ⇒ 18 km from Dhalai Beel to Seijosa via Itakhola
- ⇒ 21 km from Naharkatia to Deomali
- ⇒ 180 km from Chaparmukh to Jowai via Bhokchung, Rajagaon, Baithalangso, Jengkha, Keroni and Umrangso
- ⇒ 101 km new line alignment Dibrugarh (Tinsukia-Ledo) Makum

- Arunachal Pradesh will be connected by railway lines at multiple points with Assam. This will bring in major socio-economic development in the hilly terrain of the state
- Meghalaya will get an alternative new railway route apart from the one connecting Shillong with Guwahati





OTHER INFRASTRUCTURE & SAFETY ENHANCEMENT WORKS

- → 40 nos Road Over Bridges (ROB) constructed in Assam during 2014-24 to eliminate Railway Level Crossings for improving safety. Out of this 9 constructed in 2023-24
- ⇒ 262 nos Road Under Bridges (RUB) constructed in Assam during 2014-24; 01 of these was constructed in 2023-24



- **○** 18 additional waterways constructed to reduce the chance of flooding Railway Tracks
- **○** All Unmanned Level Crossing gates in Assam were eliminated during 2014-19
- ⇒ 23 Manned Level Crossing gates were eliminated during 2014-24 and new ROB's & RUB's were constructed in lieu of them
- **⇒** BG Coach Maintenance Depot set up at Rangapara North and Silchar during 2014-19
- Infrastructure facilities upgraded at New Bongaigaon and Dibrugarh Workshops for maintenance of High-Speed Linke Hofmann Bosch (LHB) coaches
- ◆ A new coach manufacturing unit is planned to be setup at Bogribari, Kokrajhar
- Modern Parcel station at Agthori is coming up
- → Yard remodelling of Guwahati station at a Cost Rs. 153 crore is going on
- ⇒ Yard remodelling & New Coaching complex at New Guwahati Sectioned at a Cost Rs. Rs. 227 crore
- **○** 50 stations of Assam are identified for upgradation under Amrit Bharat Stations Scheme at a cost of Rs. 2903.76 crore
- Integrated Power Supply System provided at 141 important stations during 2014-24
- **○** Work for 5 ROB's, 2 RUB's, 10 FOB's, 14 Escalators and 12 Lifts are in progress
- ⇒ 5 New Pit Lines constructed.

AMENITIES PROVIDED AT STATIONS

- **⊃** 77 **Foot Over Bridges (FOBs)** constructed during 2014-24; out of which 07 were constructed during 2023-24
- 221 Divyang toilets constructed upto March 2023
- **⇒** 245 Toilets at stations constructed during 2014-2023
- ⇒ 22 New Platforms constructed during 2014-2023; 10 of them in 2022-23
- Extension of platforms/Passenger Platform shed done in 57 stations during 2014-24. Out of which 5 during 2023-24
- ⇒ Height of 45 platforms raised during 2014-24. Out of which 5 during 2023-24
- **⇒** 23 Lifts provided during 2014-2024
- ⇒ 21 Escalators provided during 2014-24
- **○** Station Circulating Area Improved in 42 locations during 2014-24
- Soft Upgradation of Guwahati, Rangiya, and New Tinsukia stations involving new station building, waiting hall, refreshment hall and VIP lounge which was taken up during 2019-20 at a total cost of Rs 32 crore completed
- ⇒ 12 New Station Buildings inaugurated at Panchratna, Goalpara Town, Krishnai, Dudhnoi, Chaparmukh, Thekaraguri, Dharmatul, Aujuri, Jagiroad, Dhansiri, Chapar, Bechimari station during 2022-24
- ➡ Kamakhya station being developed as a world class station with addition of new facilities and targeted to be completed very soon
- **⇒** Silchar station will be developed with World Class amenities
- **○** Guwahati station received ISO-14001:2015 certification for environment management system in 2019
- ⇒ Food Plaza opened at New Tinsukia, Lumding, Guwahati during 2014-19 and in Rangiya station during 2019-20
- → Public Address System commissioned in 39 stations during 2014-24
- **⊃** Re-development of Kamakhya and Silchar station
- **⇒** 49 stations have been taken up for re-development during 2022-23
- **⊃** 7 stations are provided with 27 nos of water vending machines during 2014-24
- ⇒ 7 nos of premium lounges are constructed during 2014-24
- **⇒** 17 stations were provided with Airport standard lighting during 2014-24
- ⇒ 81 One Station One Product stall set up at various station during 2014-24. Out of which 36 were set up during 2023-24

COACH AUGMENTATION

⇒ 441 coaches were permanently augmented during 2014–24 out of which 131 coaches during 2023-24 in various trains

IMPROVEMENT OF AMENITIES IN TRAINS

During 2014-2024:

- **⇒** 42 Mail/Express trains got **On Board Housekeeping** (OBH) services
- Interior of Guwahati-Dibrugarh & Guwahati Naharlagun Shatabdi Express updraded for better aesthetic and passenger comfort under Project Swarn
- ➡ High speed LHB Coaches introduced in 31 trains
- Mechanised Cleaning of coaches of all trains originating from Assam
- **SMS/Web based Passenger Complaints Management System** introduced in all Mail/ Express trains originating from Assam
- → **High Pressure Quick Watering System** commissioned at Guwahati and Lumding stations for quick watering of all the trains passing through
- **Automatic Coach Watering Plants** will be installed soon at Dibrugarh and Silchar
- **⇒ High speed LHB Coaches** introduced **in 31 trains** of which **04 trains** during 2022-23
- **⊃** Mobile charging facility provided in all coaches
- On Board Housekeeping services provided on additional 9 trains
- **New LHB bogie** repair shop commissioned at New Bongaigaon workshop
- → All trains originating from Assam fitted with environment friendly Bio-toilets with no discharge on track
- **⇒ SCADA controlled quick watering system** installed at Badarpur Jn. station
- ⇒ LED light provided in all passenger coaches on all trains





- Digital Museums installed at 23 stations during 2014-24
- ⇒ IPIS provided at 20 stations during 2014-24; 3 of them during 2023-24
- → 78 nos of Point Of Sale (POS) machines provided in all rail head PRS counters during 2014-24 for cashless transaction
- ➡ Hand Held Terminal provided to Ticket Checking staff of many Mail/Express trains during 2014-24
- → Mobile Ticketing System introduced in non-suburban sections during 2014-24
- → All weigh bridges were integrated with FOIS during 2014-24

DIGITAL INITIATIVES

- ⇒ Free WiFi provided at 221 stations during 2014-24
- → All UTS and PRS locations provided with current booking facilities
- 6 new UTS cum PRS commissioned during 2022-23
- → Digital Train Indication Board commissioned in 9 stations during 2014-24
- → Digital Coach Indication Board commissioned in 9 stations during 2014-24



PASSENGER SECURITY

- **⇒ 525 CCTV monitoring system** provided at **17 stations** during 2014-24
- **Integrated Security System** provided at **three stations** namely **Guwahati, Lumding and Dibrugarh** during 2014-19 and at **eight** stations during 2019-24
- **○** "Child Help Line Desk" provided at Guwahati, Rangiya and Tinsukia railway station
- **⇒** "Mahila Vahini" namely Joymati Bahini & Kanaklata Bahini of RPF has been formed and "Meri Saheli" initiative has been implemented to ensure security of women passenger



GREEN INITIATIVES

- **○** All stations in Assam provided with **100% LED luminaries** during 2014-24
- **Solar power** panels of capacity **4262 KWp** installed during 2014-23 and **234 KWp** during 2023-24
- **○** Environment friendly **Bio-Toilets** with no discharge on track provided in all passenger trains including DEMU trains during 2014-24
- ⇒ **Plastic Bottle Crushing Machines** provided at Kokrajhar, Guwahati, Kamakhya, Lumding, Dimapur, Silcher, Rangiya, Barpeta Road, New Bongaigaon, New Tinsukia, station
- ⇒ Environment friendly waste to energy plant commissioned at Kamakhya in 2019 for disposal of non-recyclable waste and utilization of energy generated
- → Waste disposal incinerator (in place of HSD) for steam cleaning of BTPN wagon introduced, at New Bongaigaon Workshop
- **⇒ Bio Digester** for disposal of wet solid waste to manure is installed at 13 stations at Guwahati, New Bongaigaon, Rangiya, Dibrugarh, Silchar, Dimapur, Lumding & Badarpur
- Provision of roof top Solar Plants on 8 camping coaches provided
- ⇒ 44 nos of station are having solar panels
- **○** Guwahati station has been developed as Eco Smart station







Electrification Work sanctioned in entire Assam portion for electrification

- → 709.72 km (Track Kilometer) of Electrification has been completed in the State of Assam during 2014-23 and 520.88 during 2023-24. With this 1230.6 km (Track Kilometer) has been completed during 2014-24. Balance portion will be commissioned in 2024-25
- ➡ Electrification from Guwahati to Chaparmukh has already been commissioned and work upto Lumding has been completed on 24-03-2023

(As per Railway Board policy of 100% electrification, all other remaining sections in Assam are targeted to be completed by 2025)

FREIGHT INITIATIVES (2014-24)

- 96,860 wagons were loaded and 3,47,347 wagons were unloaded in Assam during 2023-24
- ⇒ 7,925 freight trains were unloaded in Assam during 2023-24
- Total 863 Parcel trains operated during 2021-22
- ⇒ 77 New Freight Terminal opened during 2014-24
- Modern Parcel Station is being constructed at Agthori for better handling of Parcel trains
- Business Development Units set up at Head Quarter and Divisions.
- ⇒ 21 goods terminals improved for better handling of freight and enhance efficiency
- ◆ 8 stations opened for various inbound/outbound traffic to enhance capacity during 2021-22
- **○** 502 Kisan rails were run providing market access to farmers
