#### **CAPITAL INVESTMENT**

❖ Investment over rail network in Haryana has increased manyfolds during 2014-24 as compared to the period 2009-14

- ❖ Average annual outlay of Railways in Haryana increased by 613%
- ❖ Total Outlay for 2023-24 is 2247 Cr. 61% more than 2022-24





#### Works completed during 2014-24

- ❖ 111 Km of new line projects commissioned.
- ❖ 51 Km of doubling projects commissioned
- ❖ 8 surveys for about 561 Km completed

#### Other works in the pipeline

- ❖ 7 new line projects of 557 Km for approx. 6,578 Cr.
- ❖ 3 surveys of about 327 Km of railway lines
- \* Rohtak Meham Hansi new rail line. 30 km length of Dobh-Mehani section commissioned
- Elevated corridor at Kurukshetra approximately 70% completed

#### Elevation of Rohtak - Gohana Rail line in Rohtak

- ❖ Existing Rohtak Gohana Rail line in Rohtak city converted to 4.8 Km elevated track
- Elimination of 29 level crossings
- \* Rohtak Meham Hansi New Line (68.8 Km)
- \* Reduction in traffic congestion in Rohtak city
- Indian Railways fulfilling the long standing demand of the people

#### **Utility of project:**

- ❖ Presently, Rohtak and Hisar are connected via Bhiwani, i.e. Rohtak Bhiwani & Bhiwani Hansi Hisar railway line and the distance between the two is 108 Km. On completion of this new railway link Rohtak Meham Hansi, the distance is reduced to 94 Km.
- ❖ The area in vicinity of this railway Line falls under National Capital region (NCR) and has large potential to boost industrial development of this area. Travel time is reduced substantially.
- \* Rs. 889.28 crores (sanctioned on 50:50 cost sharing basis between Railways and Haryana State and also additionally Land to be given free of Cost by Haryana State).
- Commissioned in Sept'24.

- Line commissioned and opened for movement of rail traffic








# Road Over Bridges (ROBs), Road Under Bridges (RUBs) & Unmanned Level Crossings (UMLCs)

- ❖ Road under bridge provided in lieu of level crossing Nos. 97A and 112 in Saharanpur Ambala section completed
- Facilitating uninterrupted and safe movement of road traffic
- Improving speed of trains and safety
- ❖ 33 Road Over Bridges (ROBs) and 139 Road Under Bridges (RUBs) were constructed between 2014-24 compared to 6 Road Over Bridges (ROBs) and 26 Road Under Bridges (RUBs) during 2009-14
- ❖ 123 Unmanned Level Crossings (UMLCs) have been eliminated between 2014-24 compared to 46 Unmanned Level Crossings (UMLCs) during 2009-14
- ❖ 4 Road Under Bridges (RUBs) were commissioned (3 Delhi Jn. Ambala Cantt. section and 1 Delhi Sarai Rohilla Rewari Jn. section)
- ❖ 1 Road Over Bridge (ROB) were commissioned in Delhi Sarai Rohilla -Rewari Jn. section
- Elevated corridor at Narwana Jn. Kurukshetra Jn. were commissioned, project cost appx. 100 Cr. was done by HRIDC







#### PASSENGER SECURITY

- Installation of Screening machines at all major stations
- Deployment of Railway Protection Force personnel with metal detectors
- ❖ 53 CCTV cameras installed at platforms having high footfall
- Sniffer Dog Squad deployed to check for explosives inside important trains
- ❖ 28 touts and unauthorized vendors apprehended during the period 2014-23
- ❖ 2083 children were rescued and handed over to parents or NGOs
- ❖ Deployment of additional security personnel as a special arrangement during summer rush and festival seasons for better crowd management at stations

- ❖ One Station One Product scheme announced in Union Budget 2022-23 is in line with the Government of India's 'Vocal for Local' vision. A total of 22 (Ballabhgarh, Faridabad New Town, Jakhal Jn., Narwana Jn., Sampla, Asaoti, Julana, Tohana, Faridabad, Jind Jn., Garhi Harsaru Jn., Bahadurgarh, Pataudi Road, Ganaur, PALWAL, GURGAON, Samalkha, Kurukshetra Jn., Karnal, Rohtak Jn., Sonipat, Panipat Jn.) Outlets have been installed at various stations over the state of Haryana. It creates additional income opportunities/ better livelihood conditions to local beneficiaries i.e. Local Artisans, potters, Weavers/ Handlooms etc. during the period of April 2023 to June 2024.
- ❖ Braille Signage installed for visually impaired people under CSR at 7(Gurgaon, Rohtak Jn., Panipat Jn., Karnal, Kurukshetra Jn., Sonipat, Palwal) railway stations to enable them to commute with ease and with minimal help from others.
- \* Extension of 1 no. platform at Shahbad Markanda.
- ❖ 2 no. low level platform converted to high level platform at Nanauta & Bazida Jatan for ease of passenger.
- ❖ 2 nos. Escalators have been provided at Sonipat Railway Station.
- ❖ 3 nos. lifts have been provided at Palwal railway station.



#### **DEDICATED FREIGHT CORRIDOR PROJECT**

#### **Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor (EDFC)**



- ❖ A Dedicated Freight Corridor between Ludhiana (Dhandari Kalan) and Howrah (Dankuni), passing through Haryana will connect farm and industry to ports giving a major boost to the economy of the state
- ❖ Facilitates movement of coal for power plants, ores, finished steel, food grains, cement, fertilizers, limestone and general goods
- ❖ Total Route length of 1,856 Km covering states of Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and West Bengal
- ❖ 72 Km Route is in Haryana, comprising of 7 stations New Ambala City, New Dukheri, New Kesri, New Barara, New Darazpur, New Jagadhri Workshop, New Kalanaur as loading/unloading points
- ❖ Goods trains with formation length upto 1.5 Km with maximum running speed of 100 Kmph will be operated on this route
- Decongestion of roads by shifting of freight to more efficient rail transport system
- ❖ A Green Initiative, will significantly reduce emission of Green House gases in the long run
- \* 55 Train Information LCD display board have been installed at Karnal railway station which will display the Coach Position information. It will help the passengers to locate their coach while entering the station building


