- Speed trial upto 120 Kmph completed








Road Over Bridges (ROBs) & Road Under Bridges (RUBs)


- Facilitating uninterrupted and safe movement of road traffic
- Improving speed of trains and safety
- ❖ 10 Road Over Bridges (ROBs) and 9 Road Under Bridges (RUBs) were constructed between 2009-14
- ❖ 30 Road Over Bridges (ROBs) and 134 Road Under Bridges (RUBs) were constructed between 2014-24





Elimination of Unmanned Level Crossings

- * Railway has taken giant leap in eliminating Unmanned Level Crossings (UMLCs) thereby enhancing safety in train operations
- ❖ 184 Unmanned Level Crossings were eliminated in 2009-14
- 227 Unmanned Level Crossings were eliminated in 2014-24
- 2 Level Crossings of elimination in Apr'23 to June '24

PASSENGER SECURITY

- Installation of Screening machines at all major stations
- ❖ Deployment of Railway Protection Force personnel with metal detectors
- ❖ 272 nos. cameras installed at 10 stations. (Ludhiana, Jalandhar City, Jalandhar Cantt., Phillaur Jn, Phagwara Jn, Firozpur Cantt, Pathankot Cantt., Pathankot Jn., Beas, Amritsar)
- Sniffer Dog Squad deployed to check for explosives inside important trains
- 246 children were rescued and handed over to parents or NGO's during the period 2014-23
- ❖ Deployment of additional security personnel as a special arrangement during the summer rush and 'Diwali - Chhath' festival seasons for better crowd management

CAPACITY ENHANCEMENT

Rail Coach Factory, Kapurthala

A coach manufacturing unit of Indian Railways with state-of-the-art manufacturing facilities

- Over 28,000 passenger coaches manufactured
 - Air Conditioned Sleeper: 1st, 2nd and 3 Tier
 - AC Chair Car: Executive, Economy Class and Double Decker
 - Self-Propelled passenger vehicles: Diesel Electrical Multiple Units (DEMU), Main Line Electrical Multiple Units (MEMU)
 - Non-AC: Sleeper Class, General and Luggage-cum-Brake Van
 - Others: Refrigerated Parcel Van, Inspection Coach, High Capacity Parcel Van, Accident Relief Train, Post Office Coach, AC Buffet Car and AC Power Car
- Air Conditioned train rakes produced
 - LHB type coaches: Rajdhani, Shatabdi, Duranto, semi-high speed (160 Kmph) Gatimaan, Tejas and Buddhist circuit









DEDICATED FREIGHT CORRIDOR PROJECT

Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor (EDFC)



- ❖ A Dedicated Freight Corridor between Ludhiana (Dhandari Kalan) and Howrah (Dankuni) will connect farm and industry to ports giving a major boost to the economy of Punjab
- ❖ Facilitate movement of coal for power plants, ores, finished steel, food grains, cement, fertilizers, limestone and general goods
- Total Route length of 1,856 Km covering states of Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and West Bengal
- * 88 Km route is in Punjab comprising of 6 stations New Chawapail, New Khanna, New Mandi Gobindgarh, New Sirhind, New Saraibanjara, New Shambhu that will serve as loading/unloading points
- ❖ Goods trains with formation upto 1.5 Km length having maximum running speed of 100 Kmph to run on this route
- Decongestion of roads by shifting of freight to more efficient rail transport system
- * A Green Initiative, will significantly reduce emission of Green House gases in the long run

Fast & Free Wi-Fi

- ❖ To boost Digital India Initiative, Wi-Fi facility provided at Amritsar, Jalandhar City and Ludhiana stations
- * 81 stations across Punjab have been provided with Wi-Fi facility

- 130 Point of Sale (PoS) machines provided at major stations across Punjab
- Cashless transactions can be made through BHIM, RuPay, Debit card, e-wallets etc. at ticket counters

COVID-19: INNOVATIVE USE OF ASSETS

Production of PPE Kits, Masks and Sanitizer

- ❖ 1170 coveralls were stitched at Amritsar workshop, at half the market price, for health care workers and frontline staff
- ❖ 2000 litre sanitizer produced in-house at the Amritsar workshop for mass distribution
- Hands-free washbasins and contactless soap/ sanitizer dispensers installed in offices, sheds and workshops



Isolation Coaches

Unique bid to create additional quarantine facilities to bolster country's healthcare infrastructure to tackle Covid-19 Pandemic

- ❖ Cost-effective interim medical facility for semi-urban and rural areas
- ❖ 16 patients can be accommodated per coach
- 30 Coaches placed for use as Covid Care Centre at Firozpur



- Setting up Business Development Units (BDU) at divisional level for increasing the freight business by railways
- Operation of first ever Special Express train 'Vyapar Mala' for piecemeal freight movement between Guniana - Jiribam (Tripura)







Infrastructure
