**Sub.:- Recruitment of sportspersons against sports quota.**

**Ref. :- RWFSa's letter No. Nil dt. 04.02.2008.**

Please refer to Hony. General Secretary, RWFSa's dt. 04.02.2008 seeking clarification on recruitment of a sportsperson in Group-C on the basis of his Gold Medal winning performance in Jr. National Hockey Championship, by representing Air India team.

In this connection it is clarified that as per Para 4.1(ii) of Board's policy letter No. E(Sports)/2007/Policy/3 dt. 30.03.2007, a sportsperson is eligible for recruitment in Group-C, if he/she represented a state or equivalent unit in Junior/Senior National Championship and obtained at least 3<sup>rd</sup> position. **The equivalent unit includes the teams participating in the championship other than State teams.** Therefore, Air India team may also be treated as an equivalent unit and the candidate is eligible for recruitment in Group-C for his Gold medal winning performance in Jr. National Hockey Championship by representing Air India team.

However, it is advised that the candidate may be asked to submit No Objection Certificate from Air India, if he is presently an employee of Air India, before the issuing the offer of appointment.
