**Sub: Treatment of absence of Railway employees for participation in Sports activities
as 'on Duty'.**

1. The question of treating the period of participation of Railway Sportspersons and officials in Inter Railway Championships organized under the auspices of Railway Sports Control Board has been under consideration of the Board. After careful deliberation, the Board have decided that participation of specified number of teams, including officials, sportspersons in various Inter Railway Championships in team events or individual events and technical officials be treated as duty.
2. While the sportspersons, who broadly qualify for this facility have been included in the List at Annexure 'A' RSCB will circulate the particulars of such teams/sportspersons/ technical officials before organization of the various Inter-Railway tournaments.

3. The following safeguards must be observed with a view to preventing any misuse of this facility and their compliance ensured:

- i) Only actual participation days of the Inter-Railway Championship plus the to and fro journey period is to be treated as 'on duty'.
- ii) Preparatory camps, prior to participation in Inter-Railway Tournaments, will continue to remain as on SCL.
- iii) Actual duration of various Inter-Railway tournaments will not exceed the period specified in Annexure 'B'.
- iv) In the team games, the maximum number of members and the officials accompanying a team will be as specified in Annexure 'B'.
- v) Number of referees, umpires, technical officials required for proper conduct of the Inter-Railway tournaments, will be as specified in Annexure 'B'.

4. The entitlement of these sport sportspersons to SCL will automatically get curtailed with Inter-Railway participation being treated as 'Duty'.

5. These orders take effect from 01.09.1991

6. This has the sanction of the President and issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.

**Standards laid down for teams/sportspersons eligible for treating participation in
Inter-Railway Tournaments as on duty**

In **TEAM GAMES** i.e. Badminton, Ball Badminton, Basketball, Bridge, Chess, Cricket, Cross Country, Football, Golf, Hockey, Kabaddi, Rifle Shooting, Table Tennis, Tennis, Volleyball and Water Polo, the facility will be applicable to:

- i) Team finishing in 1st eight position during the previous year's Inter-Railway Championship where total participation is of 10 or more teams.
- ii) Teams finishing in 1st four position when total participation is of less than 10 teams.

In **game based on INDIVIDUAL performance** such as Athletics, Billiards, Body-Building, Boxing, Cycling, Gymnastics, Swimming, Weight-Lifting and Wrestling, the following will be eligible for the proposed facility:

- i) Sportsperson finishing in first 6 positions in an event during previous Inter-Railway meet.
- ii) Sportspersons who were members of the Indian Railway teams in the previous National or those who finish in 1st six positions during the previous National.
