It is, therefore, requested to finally send the compliance of **safety drives/safety audits** wherein:

- i) it should be approved by GM/PHOD.
- ii) it should only be signed by the CSO and not other officers.
- iii) CSO must go through the compliance submitted by the division and indicate defects/deficiencies in them. Time frame within which the shortcomings noticed will be attended to, should also be indicated in the CSO's letter.

It is requested to kindly follow the above directive with immediate effect.
