Sub: Inter Railway Safety Audit Inspections.

Please refer to Board's letters of even number dated 20.10.2014 & 31.10.2014 vide which instructions were issued for carrying out Inter-Railway Safety Inspections. Some Zonal Railways have requested Board to change nomination of the Railway allotted to them for inspection. Board has considered the matter and decided to change the nomination for conducting inspections as per the following schedule, which will be effective from January/2017.

The following instructions/guidelines issued from time to time reg. Safety Audits should be adhered to:-

- 1. The Audit schedule will be six monthly and it will be conducted in the two blocks of January June and July December.
- 2. The multi disciplinary Inter-Railway Safety Team will consist of SAG officers of Traffic, Mechanical, Civil, Electrical and Signalling department with CSO as convener, irrespective of the department to which CSO belongs to. It may be ensured that there is no exception to the constitution of the teams, which should consist of SAG officers only as advised above. The convenor of Safety Team will be responsible for organizing the schedule of the inspection and the other members would be expected to adhere to the said schedule unless otherwise permitted or authorised by the competent authority.
- 3. It has been noticed that some Railways fail to carry out two audits in a year, which has been viewed seriously by Board. Railways are advised to first submit their previous Audit Report/Action taken Report, if pending, before carrying out inspection as per revised nomination. If any Railway has failed to conduct their inspection, reason(s) for the same may be advised.
- 4. Abnormalities and system deficiencies noticed during the inspection should be submitted as a report to General Manager of the Railway and Railway Board within a week of the date of inspection jointly signed by all members of the Safety Team. The inspected Railway will have to send the compliance within 15 days of the receipt of inspection.
- 5. The Audit parameters should be segregated under two heads viz. 'Safety; & 'Non-Safety'. Safety parameters should predominate the report.
- 6. Major deficiencies and action taken thereon should also be summarized in one page.
- 7. The column indicating the action taken by the Railway should be juxtaposed against the respective deficiencies/shortcomings pointed out by the audit team.
- 8. Apart from sending hard copy, the report and their compliance should also invariably be uploaded on SMDMS and may be emailed at safetyimp345@qmail.com.
