> Sub: Online monitoring of post accident activities. Ref: This office letter of even no. dated 17.05.2017.

Railway Board vide letter under reference advised Zonal Railways regarding the check sheet for monitoring post-accident activities so as to obtain authentic, updated information timely from the field regarding accident details, movement of relief trains, restoration progress, details of injured passengers etc. For online updation and generation of the accident monitoring log sheet, a feature is developed as a part of accident report. Once an accident ID is created "Add/update accident monitoring log sheet" will be automatically created and mapped under the accident ID under the hyperlink "view more". There is a provision to edit the data entered in the log sheet and view the report.

Zonal Railways shall ensure that post an accident, SIMS ID is created at the earliest, it is suggested that this process should be completed within the first hour of an accident so that the details in the accident monitoring log sheet can be filled up. It is expected that on occurrence of an event, for an example, movement of ART or ARMV or arrival of ART or ARMV to the accident site etc., needs to be entered and updated periodically.

Chief Safety Officers may please advise all concerned for continuous updation of post-accident events in the accident monitoring log sheet.
