Sub: Re-deployment of Loco Running Staff/Motorman involved in SPAD cases.

References were received from Southern Railway and Central Railway seeking clarification regarding number of attempts to be given to the Loco Running Staff for the aptitude test (previously known as psychological test) who were involved in SPAD.

Accordingly, the matter has been examined and the following has been decided:

A Running staff who was involved in SPAD should be allowed only one attempt for the psychological test. In case the staff fails in the psychological test, he/she should be taken out from running duties and deployed in stationary/non-running duties.

Further, Railways may refer to Railway Board's letter No.2017/Safety(A&R)/18/11 dated 08.01.2018 for other details.
