Please refer your Railway's letter under reference on the above subject. Necessary amendments to GRs 3.65 (Description of Flare Signals), 3.66 (Use of Flare Signals), 3.67 (Knowledge and Possession of Flare Signals) have been carried out and Gazette Notified which have already been intimated to the Zonal Railways and all concerned. It can be seen that mention of signal fusee has been completely deleted from GR and henceforth, LED based flashing hand signal lamps (HSL) are to be used for this purpose. As such, fusee signals are not required to be stocked by the Railways, unless otherwise prescribed by Special Instructions. A copy of the letter dated 14.12.2009 is sent herewith for your information and necessary action.
