Subsidiary Rule 5.16-1 of Central Railway has been examined. Board (MT) has accorded its approval to the same with the following remarks:-

"Shunt movements are carried out at slow speeds under close supervision of shunting staff provided for this purpose. In large yards with old alignments it is not possible to isolate each and every movement by changes in yard layouts. CR's proposal is approved. However, wherever feasible (for future), we may provide isolation at minimal cost just as an abundant precaution and not as an omnibus requirement."

In view of the above, Central Railway may continue with the existing SR 5.16-1 and comply with the guidelines as above.
