At times information regarding passenger train accidents is flashed in the media even before it is known in the Board's office resulting in avoidable embarrassment. Instructions already exist that all passenger train accidents or other occurrences involving casualties or having serious repercussions on movement of traffic should be promptly reported to CRB by the concerned GM, or in his absence by the AGM or COM.

CRB has desired that the above instructions may be scrupulously followed.
