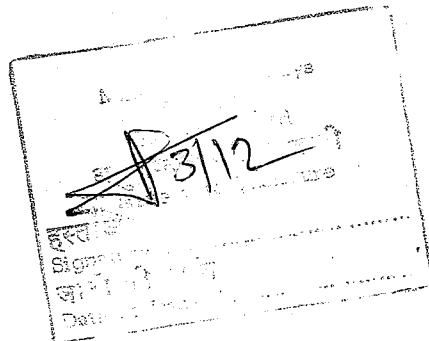


Vide Railway Board's letter No. 2005/Safety (A&R)/6/4 dated  
2.8.2007, Railways were advised that Accident Enquiry Report with  
Foreign Railway staff responsibility should be put up to SDGM where  
there is no post of AGM in the Railway.

Reference has been received from CSO, North Central Railway vide  
his above referred letter wherein he has mentioned that the post of CSO  
has been made multidisciplinary similar to the post of SDGM and both the  
posts are of SAG level and on some Railways, CSOs are even senior to  
SDGM. He has proposed that Accident Enquiry Reports involving Foreign  
Railway staff should be accepted by the CSO instead of SDGM, on  
Railways where post of AGM is not existing to streamline and expedite  
finalization of enquiry reports.

Railways are requested to submit their views on the above proposal  
before the same is put up to Board.
