

In partial modification of Directive-56 regarding shortlisting for screening of RPF personnel for Crime Wing, the following guidelines are being issued:-

The Sub Para D of Para 6 of the Directive-56 may be read as under:-

Existing Provision	Modified Provision
The shortlisted candidate should be free from DAR proceedings vigilance/criminal cases and should not be undergoing any penalty. They should have clean record of service of at least 5 years (Candidates having less than 5 years of service and not worked in field for at least 3 years should not be considered for posting in Detective & Investigative Cell of Crime Wing).	The shortlisted candidates should be free from DAR proceedings/ vigilance/ criminal cases & should not be undergoing any penalty and involved in any activity of moral turpitude in past or present.
