STANDING ORDER NO.23.

Sub: Representation from RPF personnel for
transfer, promotion etc.

The following guidelines may be followed in
dealing with representations in connection with
transfer, promotion etc. of RPF personnel:-

- a) The representations received from RPF personnel through proper channel will be examined by the CSCs on merits in the light of the existing Rules and if the matter is beyond the powers of the CSC, the same will be forwarded to the DG/RPF with specific comments indicating inter-alia whether there are extra-ordinary circumstances meriting waiver of existing rules and instructions on the subject.
- b) All RPF personnel should be informed that representations received from relatives and well-wishers etc. will not be entertained.
- c) RPF personnel who bring extraneous pressure through relations, MPs/MLAs and other outsiders will be taken up under the extant instructions.

This may be brought to the notice of all personnel of the Force.
