
STANDING ORDER No.63

Subj: Authorisation of percentage of weapons - Revision.

In terms of Para 2.2 of DGM/RPF's Standing Order No. 13 issued under Railway Board's letter of even number dated 7.6.97, only 40% of weapons were authorized for N.E. Railway. In view of the delicate and challenging security scenario at present in that Zone, the authorisation of weapons over N.E. Railway is, therefore, revised to 100%. The break-up of weapons, as per this revised authorization, will henceforth, be as under over that Railway.

1. Rifles 7.62 mm (SLR)	-	40%
2. AK-47/AK-57 (Rifles 7.62 mm)	-	20%
3. Carbine Machines 9 mm LA	-	30%
4. Pistols Auto 9 mm LA	-	10%

2. Similarly, due to security reasons, the authorisation of weapons of RPSE, is also revised. The present 100% weapon authorisation of RPSE, will now include 20% of AK-47/AK-57 (Rifles 7.62 mm) also.
