In order to ensure that the wat to want of the coy at Battalion Headquarters does not suffer during the absence of the loss in Comdt from Battalion headquarters while on tour of his company, the dealing clerk of the coy, which is deployed outside the Bn/Hq. may accompany the Assit. Comdt. of the company during tours. This will ensure that both the Assit. Comdt. and dealing eleck of a tone place at a given time.
- 4. The Sr.DSCs/DSCs under phose jurispiction the RPSF coys are deployed will ensure proper accommodation as per criticism and for the Assit. Condis. of the RPSF coys.
