ADDENDUM

Sub: Directive 32 (Addendum).

Ref: Directive 32 issued vide letter of even number dated:18.09.2014 & modified vide letter of even number dated:28.05.2015, 02.12.2015, 02.01.2016, 11.02.2016 & 18.04.2017.


Para 4(a) of Directive 32 issued vide Board's letter No.2014/Sec(Spl)/6/12 dated: 18.09.2014 and modified vide addendum of even number dated: 28.05.2015 may be referred.

It has been decided to delete the condition of minimum service period of three (03) years, including training period, for 'mutual transfer', transfer on 'working couple grounds' and in cases where 'staff is care giver to disabled child'.

Accordingly, Para 4(a) of Directive 32 stands modified and shall be read as under:-

Para 4(a): Sub-Inspectors and Constables in RPF shall be eligible for inter-zonal transfer on completion of 10 years of service, including training period. In cases of request transfer of women Sub-Inspectors and Women Constables, the eligibility for inter-zonal transfer shall be 05 years of service from the date of appointment after completion of training. However, the condition of minimum service period shall not be applied in cases of 'mutual transfer', transfer on 'working couple grounds' and in such cases where staff is 'care-givers to a disabled child'. Provided that such staff have completed probation period and are free from DAR/Vigilance/CBI/Criminal cases.
