Directive No. 42

Sub: Creation of Special Wing in RPSF.

In terms of Rule 7 and 17 of RPF Rules 1987 a Special Wing is being created for smooth supervision and management of the force and for better protection and security of Railway property, passenger area and passengers.

OBJECTIVE:-

Main objective of creation of Special Wing in RPSF is to fore-warn the railway administration regarding activities of RPSF/RPF staff, railway employees, outsiders etc which are likely to have adverse effect on functioning of railways in general and RPSF in particular.

The set up of the special wing for RPSF shall be as under:-


1. **Company Level-** Each company of RPSF including HQ Company will have one SI/ASI posted as SI/ASI Special Wing.
2. **Battalion Level-** Each Battalion will have One Inspector and Two Constables/ Head Constables posted in the branch.
3. **RPSF Head Quarter-** In the office of PCSC/RPSF, there shall be a special wing headed by an Assistant Commandant assisted by One Inspector, Two SIs/ASIs and Two Head Constable/Constable. The AC/Special Wing will direct and supervise the functioning of special wing and internal vigilance. AC/SW will report to CSC/RPSF.

Duties and functions of the wing:-

The officers and members posted in this wing will discharge the following responsibilities:

1. Collect and share intelligence regarding-
 - (i) Grievances of the members of the force which, if remained un-addressed, are likely to result in disruption of smooth functioning of the RPSF.
 - (ii) To collect and share information regarding acts of indiscipline among officers or Non Gazetted personnel which have potential to cause disruption in smooth functioning of RPSF.

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- (iii) Report any kind of groupism among the members of the force on the basis of caste, creed, region, religion and gender etc which is likely to cause disharmony or disaffection among the members of force.
 - (iv) Any behavior of the members of the force which is detrimental to safety, security and general well being of the member her/himself or others, for example excessive alcoholism, drug addiction, Mental disturbance, radicalism etc.
 - (v) Any other information, related to member of the force or outsiders, requiring immediate attention and action on part of the administration.
2. Co-ordinate and hold meetings with the representatives of police, other intelligence agencies and share intelligence.
 3. Collation and analysis of intelligence inputs and sharing actionable inputs promptly with the CO/CC.
 4. Receipt of intel inputs from Intelligence Cell, Railway Board, other units of RPF/RPSF, other LEA/police/Intel agencies and communication to CO/CC.

The intelligence collected should be sent in real time by Company level ASI/ SI to AC/ Special Wing in the office of PCSC/RPSF under intimation to concerned CO, AC and Coy Commander. The AC special Wing in RPSF should collate and analyse all such inputs on real time basis and send messages directly to DIG/ MAC and IG/DIG RPSF simultaneously. Any input considered to be of urgent nature be scanned & sent by Whatsapp or other similar means to recipients mentioned above. DIG/ MAC would keep DG, ADG & IG/ C&I apprised of all such inputs which he considers necessary. Appropriate records and registers, shall be maintained at all levels.
