Sub: Directive-32 (revised)-modification

Ref.: Board's letter of even no. dated 28.12.2017

In partial modification of the provisions contained in Directive 32 (revised), the following guidelines are being issued in so far as transfer and posting of RPSF personnel are concerned:-

1. Para 2 (A) (viii) and (ix) stand deleted.
2. Tenure for Non-Gazetted RPSF personnel will be treated as under:-

Category	Group A (Bn 2 nd , 3 rd , 6 th , 9 th & 15 th)	Group B (Remaining Bns except 16 th Bn Mahila Bn)	Justification
HQ Coy	5 Year Tenure	5 year tenure	Staff in HQ Coy has permanency of 5 years at Bn Hqrs, hence staff from operational Coy wants attachment to HQ Coy. Reduction of tenure will afford chance to others for posting in HQ Coy.
Operational Coy	5 Year Tenure	10 Year Tenure, extendable by 5 years	Group A Battalions are in demand on account of large number of staff being from the states of U.P., Haryana and Rajasthan. 5 year tenure in these Battalions will ensure rotation and chance to staff from other Bn to get a posting in these Bn thereby reducing the pressure of premature transfer and attachments on various grounds.

Ancillary, Armourer, Wireless	5 year Tenure	10 year extendable by 5 years	Same as above. Plus, the category of Ancillary, Armourer and Wireless are available in all Battalions
Drivers	10 years	10 years extendable by 5 years	Same as above, However, their tenure is kept at 10 years in Group A Battalions as drivers are familiar with roads and layout of cities, hence 10 year tenure will facilitate smooth movement of vehicles in their area.
Request Transfer	2 years	2 years	--

3. The following provision shall be added after para 3 (xi):-

“This provision will not be applicable to RPSF.”

4. If a member completes 3 years either in continuous or broken spell in HQ Coy, he shall be transferred out of Battalion after 5 years i.e. for him the tenure would be 5 years in a Battalion.

5. Attachment: The limitation for attachment shall be as follows (in a block of one year)

Period	Intra Battalion	Inter Battalion
Up to 30 days	CO	CSC
Up to 60 days	CSC	PCSC
Up to 90 days	PCSC	PCSC
Above 90 days	DG	DG


6. New Recruits batches: Before posting of new batches, all request transfer shall be disposed off and the staff in new batches may preferably be posted in Group B Battalions.

7. Last Tenure: The staff having two years left in retirement may be preferably posted in Battalion of his choice.


8. Education Ground: One year extension in tenure may be given to staff whose wards are studying in class 10th or 12th.

9. Inter Coy Rotation may be done every 2 years by concerned CO. For premature rotation, approval of PCSC should be obtained.
