In exercise of powers conferred under Rule 23 of R.P.F. Rules, 1987 read with Section 8 of the R.P.F. Act, 1957, the Director General/R.P.F. hereby issues the following directives:-

DIRECTIVE NO. 13.

Sub:- Ministerial Cadre in R.P.S.F.

There shall be a Ministerial Cadre in R.P.S.F. which will consist of the following ranks:-

S.No.	Office.	Designation.
1.	Inspector (Ministerial) Grade-II.	Inspector Grade-II.
2.	Sub-Inspector (Clerk).	Sub-Inspector.
3.	Sub-Inspector (Steno).	Sub-Inspector.
4.	Asstt. Sub-Inspector (Typist - Clerk).	Asstt. Sub-Inspector.

The posts of ASI (Typist - Clerk) will be filled up through departmental competitive examination from amongst Constables/Naiks and Head Constables having completed 5 years regular service who are matriculate and type knowing. They will be required to qualify type-writing test with 50 words per minute in English or 25 words per minute in Hindi.

The posts of Sub-Inspectors/Steno will be filled up from amongst ASI (Typist - Clerk) who qualify stenography test with 30 words per minute after completing 5 years regular service in the grade.


The posts of Sub-Inspector (Typist - Clerk) will be filled up from amongst ASI (Typist - Clerk) who have completed 5 years regular service in the grade.

The posts of Inspector (Ministerial) Grade-II will be filled up from amongst SI (Steno) and SI (Clerk) who completed 3 years of regular service in the grade.

Candidates who are selected as Asstt. Sub-Inspector (Typist - Clerk) will be entitled for promotion in the Ministerial Cadre only up to the level of Inspector Gr. II. The Departmental Promotion Committee for promotion to the rank of ASI and from ASI to SI and from SI to Inspector Gr. II will be as per provisions contained in R.P.F. Rules 70 and 72. Further promotion from Inspector Gr. II to Inspector Grade-I will be in Executive Cadre.

The Directive will come into force with immediate effect.
