Sub:- Posting of young directly recruited
gazetted officeres in RPF.

It has been decided that henceforth all directly recruited gazetted officers and those recruited as S.Is., on their first appointment subject to the vacancies should be posted to difficult/heavy Railway, which provide them better opportunity to learn the complex working of Railway network and indepth working knowledge especially relating to prevention and detection of crime against Railway property.

The initial tenure will be for a period of five years. During this period they will also be given exposure to the working and functioning of RPSF Battalions for atleast two years to understand special features and working of Armed Battalions.

On completion of their hard posting, they may be considered for posting to other lighter Railways.
