**Sub: Interlocking of Manned Level Crossings with high TVUs.**

In the wake of the recent accident at a busy Level Crossing Gate on one of the Zonal Railway, Chairman Railway Board has expressed his serious concern over continued non-interlocking of busy Manned Level Crossing gates on Indian Railways. He has directed to draw a time bound action plan to complete the work of interlocking such LC gates.

2. On review, it has come to notice that there are over 200 level crossing gates on the Indian Railways having TVUs in excess of 50,000, which are not planned to be eliminated by ROB/RUBs in next 6 months and are still non-interlocked.
3. Zonal Railways are advised to focus on this vital area of safety enhancement and take up the works on a war footing. Action Plan of the Railway to complete the work within the current financial year for interlocking at all balance gates having TVUs in excess of 50,000 and which are not planned to be eliminated by ROB/RUB in next 6 months may be submitted for perusal of Board in next 15 days.
4. Wherever the works are not sanctioned, the same may be done under Zonal powers.
