

84th SSC meeting was held on 20th and 21st April, 2016 at Ahmedabad of Western Railway. Recommendations of the SSC on agenda items vis-à-vis remarks of Signal Dte are as under:-

Item No.	Item	SSC recommendations	Railway Board's Remarks
Informal	Provision of Emergency Backup Panel at Stations.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For stations with less than 100 routes, Railways can decide on themselves on the type of backup panel. 2. For stations with more than 100 routes and less than 400 routes, portable NI Panel with NI home, Starter and Advanced Starter (Interlocked with Block) having provision for operation / detection of 8 Nos. of crossovers and track locking shall be prewired and kept ready at a central location for immediate transportation to the affected station. Speeds to be limited to 15 Kmph only. 3. For stations with more than 400 routes, one spare EI of each make (without hot standby) shall be kept ready by each Zonal Railway at a central location. Zonal Railway shall keep EPROMS loaded with FAT tested application logic ready for such station for use in case of any eventuality.. 	SSC's recommendations No. 1 & 2 of this item are accepted.
