Sub:- Utilisation of Data logger for linking arrival/departure of trains with COA.

Ref:- Railway Board's L/No. 2010/Sig/SGF/12 dtd. 14.11.2011.

With respect to above, Zonal Railways were instructed to link arrival/departure of trains from data logger with control office applications (COA). Initially, approval was given for 17 interchange points and 17 terminal stations. As on date, data logger has been linked at 65 locations on Indian Railways.

The issue of deteriorating punctuality over the Indian Railways was discussed in the Board's Office and it was decided that Data logger should be linked with COA for updating arrival/departure of trains automatically at all the Divisional interchange points and terminal stations. Zonal Railways may get the necessary works sanctioned for linking the data loggers with COA within the General Managers' powers and execute the same at the earliest.
