During Railway Board's safety review meetings, it has already been highlighted to divisions that 26-Week Rolling Block Plan should be prepared and implemented by all Divisions in the right earnest jointly by all the concerned departments as per guidelines vide ref.(i) dated 06.12.2024.

The Rolling Block utilization is also one of the Key Performance Indicator (KPI) of annual performance of Zonal Railways. The weekly position of 26-Week Rolling Block Plan submitted by Divisions on every Saturday is being monitored at the highest level. However, it is observed that few divisions (as listed out in Annexure-A) are more frequently found in exception to not adhering to timely submission of their position through respective Sr. DEN/Coord.

Further, para 1.5 of the guideline mandates the following:

"DRMs to exercise checks for consolidation and/or correctness of blocks planed by various stake holders, to optimize usage of blocks. DRM should ensure that the targets achievable are realistic and required resources have been planned, including clubbing of resources where required. Further DRMs to also pool in various resources and action required for execution of planned works in block time which results in minimum disruption."

In view of above, it is reiterated that implementation of Rolling Block Plan as per guideline vide ref. (i) above, should be reviewed by DRMs more qualitatively with emphasis on utilization of Rolling Block Plan to further improve upon efficiency and output for proper asset maintenance.

Needful action should be taken on the matter for effective implementation
