SUB: AUTOMOBILE FREIGHT TRAIN OPERATOR (AFTO) SCHEME.**Ref:** Freight Marketing Circular No.11 of 2013 dated 21.05.2013

Vide Freight Marketing Circular No.11 of 2013 issued under Board's letter No. 2010/TC(FM)/25/4 Pt-I dated 21.05.2013 Freight table and composition of BCACBM wagon and Terminal Access charge recoverable from Automobile Freight Train Operators were notified.

The matter has been reviewed and it has been decided that to revise the rates of Haulage charge recoverable for the movement of 'BCACBM'. The revised rates are given in Annexure to this circular.

The rates given in this circular shall come into force w.e.f. 01.04.2023 and shall remain in force till 31.03.2024.

Terminal Access Charge under Freight Marketing Master Circular/AFTO/2021/0 dated 26.10.2021 shall be as under:



Both terminals are private terminals	Nil
Both terminals are Railways	₹ 81,000 per rake
One terminal is private and one is Railway terminal	₹ 40,500 per rake

Minimum composition of BCACBM rake shall be 27 wagons.

This shall be in supersession of previous instruction issued vide Board's letter under reference.




