

**Sub: Permissible Carrying Capacity of BOBSN wagons on 25 tonne axle load routes.**

**Ref: Board's letter of even number dated 15.04.2009 (RC No.29 of 2009)**

1. In partial modification of Rates Circular No.29 of 2009, sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to fix the Permissible Carrying Capacity (PCC) of BOBSN wagons as 61 tonne on 25 tonne axle load routes for loading of all commodities.
2. All other details of the Rates Circular No.29 of 2009 will continue to apply unchanged.
3. These instructions will come into force w.e.f. 20-11.2009.
4. This issues in consultation with Traffic Transportation and Mechanical Engineering Directorates and with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
