

Sub: Rationalisation of rates for Luggage and Parcel traffic effective from 01.10.2013.

1. Sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to rationalize the rate structure for booking of Parcel & Luggage. A copy of the revised Parcel & Luggage Fare Tables is **enclosed herewith.**
2. The sanction of the Central Government is also accorded for the following:-
“For Rajdhani/Shatabdi/Duronto trains parcel rates would be 25% over the Scale “R”.
3. Registered Magazines and Registered Newspapers will continue to be booked at concessional rates uniformly at 45 per cent of Scale-S by all trains including Rajdhani trains.
4. Copies of Parcel & Luggage Fare Tables containing revised rates for luggage and parcel may be collected from IRCA.
5. Special arrangements should be made to ensure that necessary instructions and the revised Parcel & Luggage Fare Tables reach the staff well in time. Steps should also be taken to ensure that the staff fully understand these changes and implement them properly. Commercial Inspectors (CMIs) and Traffic Inspectors of accounts (TIAs) should be deputed for ensuring correct implementation of the instructions and the revised rates.
6. These instructions shall be applicable from 01.10.2013.
7. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.




