In continuation of instructions contained in Board's above referred Circulars, Ministry of Railways have decided as under:

- (i) Exemption from 100% weighment, subject to random 20% weighment, of perishable items (including Mango, Banana and Orange traffic) transported in all types of parcel rakes comprising of parcel vans (VPU/VPH/VP etc.).
- (ii) Punitive charges for overloading beyond the carrying capacity of all types of parcel rakes comprising of parcel vans (VPU/VPH/VP etc.) for transportation of all perishables (including Mango, Banana and Orange traffic) shall be @R-Scale plus ₹10,000/-, instead of 6 times of R-Scale plus ₹10,000.
- (iii) Mango, banana and Orange traffic transported in BCN/BCX/BCNA/BCNAHS wagons on concessional parcel scale rates shall also be exempted from 100% weighment, subject to random 20% weighment; and punitive charges for overloading, if any, shall also be @R-Scale plus ₹10,000/-, instead of 6 times of R-Scale plus ₹10,000.
- 2. Other terms and conditions shall remain the same.
- 3. These instructions shall be effective with immediate effect.
- 4. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
