Sub: Haulage Charges recoverable for movement of 'milk traffic' in Rail Milk Tankers(RMT) owned by private parties.

Haulage Charges recoverable for movement of 'milk traffic' in Rail Milk Tankers(RMT) owned by private parties were last revised vide FM Circular No.07 of 2018 dated 14.03.2018, which were applicable for the period 01.07.2018 to 30.06.2019. The same Haulage Charges were further extended vide FM Circulars No.16 of 2019 dated 24.06.2019, 17 of 2020 dated 29.09.2020, and 15 of 2021 dated 15.07.2021.

- 2. Haulage Charges for new high-capacity Rail Milk Tankers (VVNH1) are calculated by multiplying the Haulage Charges for VVN (old design of RMTs) with a factor of 1.12, asper FM Circular No.23 of 2019 dated 11.09.2019.
- 3. Ministry of Railways has now decided to revise the Haulage Charges for movement of 'milk traffic', applicable from 01.07.2022 till 30.06.2023, as under:

(a)	Haulage Charges for loaded RMTs(VVN)	₹94 per Vehicle Km (per 8-wheeler milk tanker)
(b)	Empty RMTs (VVN) for change of base or for POH	₹47 per Vehicle Km (per 8-wheeler milk tanker).

- 4. Haulage Charges for new high-capacity Rail Milk Tankers (VVNH1) shall continued to be charged @1.12 times of the applicable Haulage Charges for VVN, in compliance with FM Circular No.23 of 2019 dated 11.09.2019.
- 5. No charges shall be levied for empty movements of RMTs from unloading points to the loading points for re-loading.
- 6. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
