Representations have been received from Zonal Railways seeking guidelines regarding permission for advance stacking at originating station for parcels to be loaded in indented 'Parcel Vans' and 'Parcel trains'.

In the matter of indented Parcel trains, instructions have already been issued vide Railway Board's letter dated 08.08.2018 (ref-iii, copy enclosed).

In the matter of stacking permission for indented Parcel Vans, it has been decided that permission and time for advance stacking at the originating station, as well as time for removal at the destination station, may be granted <u>similar</u> to the provisions already available in the 'Comprehensive Parcel Leasing Policy (CPLP)' as applicable for leased Parcel Vans.

However, it shall be ensured that stacking permission is not granted on platforms where passenger-carrying trains are also dealt with, and that there is no unnecessary stacking within the Railway premises.

This issues in consultation with Coaching Directorate, and with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.

Vide letters under reference wherein Central railway has sought clarification in the granting of advance stacking permission in case of non-leased (INDENT) PCET.

The matter has been examined in consultation with Traffic Commercial (Rates) Branch in Board's office.

It is clarified that the rolling stock in PCET and demand VP rake is identical. Advance stacking can be done as per PCET guidelines. However, Zonal Railways may take a final decision on the period of advance stacking taking into consideration the occupancy of goods shed and in the best interest of the Railways.

Necessary action may be taken accordingly.
