Sub: Haulage Charges for postal traffic for 2021-22 and 2022-23

Ref: 1. Railway Board's Freight Marketing Circulars No. 09 of 2021 dated 28.05.2021

2. DDG/Mail Operations letter no. 3-1/2021-D dated 06/09.05.2022

Haulage charges for Postal traffic carried in Postal Vans and Non-Postal Vans for the year 2020-21 were revised vide ref-i above.

2. As agreed by Department of Posts (vide letter under ref-ii) and approved by Ministry of Railways, Haulage Charges from the year 2021-22 onwards are to be revised as per the existing methodology on the basis of change in WPI-with 100% increase/decrease in WPI to be borne by Department of Posts.

3. Accordingly, It has now been decided to revise the Haulage charges for Postal Traffic carried in Postal Vans and Non-Postal Vans for the year 2021-22 and 2022-23 as per the aforementioned methodology, as under:
