BOBRNHS, BRHNEHS and BOBYNHS wagons.**

1.0 Sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to fix the Permissible Carrying Capacity of BOBRNHS, BRHNEHS and BOBYNHS wagons as per the following:

<b>BRHNEHS</b>	64 Tonne	66 Tonne	68 Tonne	68 Tonne	1 Tonne

2.0 It has also been decided that the standard rake size and minimum number of wagons required to be loaded for availing trainload benefit for BOBRNHS, BRHNEHS and BOBYNHS wagons may be fixed as under:

Type of Wagons	Standard Rake Size	Minimum Number of wagons to be loaded for availing Trainload benefit
<b>BOBRNHS</b>	<b>59</b>	<b>57</b>
<b>BRHNEHS</b>	<b>42</b>	<b>40</b>
<b>BOBYNHS</b>	<b>54</b>	<b>52</b>

3.0 These instructions will come into force w.e.f. 27.07.2012 and will remain valid till further advice.

4.0 All other details of Rates Circular Numbers 28 of 2011 and 62 of 2009, as amended from time to time, will remain unchanged.

5.0 This issues in consultation with Traffic Transportation, Mechanical Engineering and Civil Engineering Directorates and with concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.


