**Sub: Rebate in freight to (i) M/s BALCO for transportation of Alumina,
(ii) M/s Rajshree Cement for transportation of bulk cement and
(iii) M/s Vedanta Aluminium Ltd. for transportation of Caustic soda.**



1.0 In terms of Rates Circular under reference, sanction was accorded to grant rebate in freight for bulk cement, Alumina and Caustic Soda when loaded and transported in privately owned BCCW, BTAPHP and BTCS wagons respectively subject to fulfilment of certain terms and conditions as stipulated therein. These instructions are valid up to 30-09-2012.

2.0 The matter has been reviewed and it has been decided to grant rebate in freight beyond 30.09.2012 for a further period of one year i.e. from 01.10.2012 to 30.09.2013 as under:

3.0 The percentage rebate indicated above would remain in force from 01-10-2012 to 30-09-2013.




4.0 It may be ensured that before the rebate in freight indicated above is notified, necessary agreement for the transport of traffic in privately owned wagons is entered into by the party with the Railways.

5.0 All other terms and conditions as stipulated in Rates Circulars Nos.60 of 2009 and 15 of 2010 and corrigendum thereto will continue to apply unchanged.

6.0 This is issued with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.


